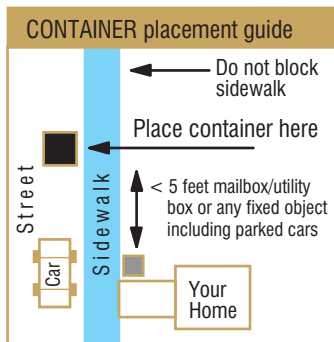

Residential Curbside Trash and Recycling Services (east of I-17)

As an Anthem resident, you will receive residential curbside service two times per week. One time per week for trash and one time per week for recycling services. Your scheduled service days are determined by your service area. Please see the Area Map and the Curbside Trash and Recycling Service Schedule to determine your scheduled days. Please place containers on the street the night prior to collection or by 6:00 am on your assigned collection day. For safe and efficient service, please place the container in the street with the wheels touching the curb.

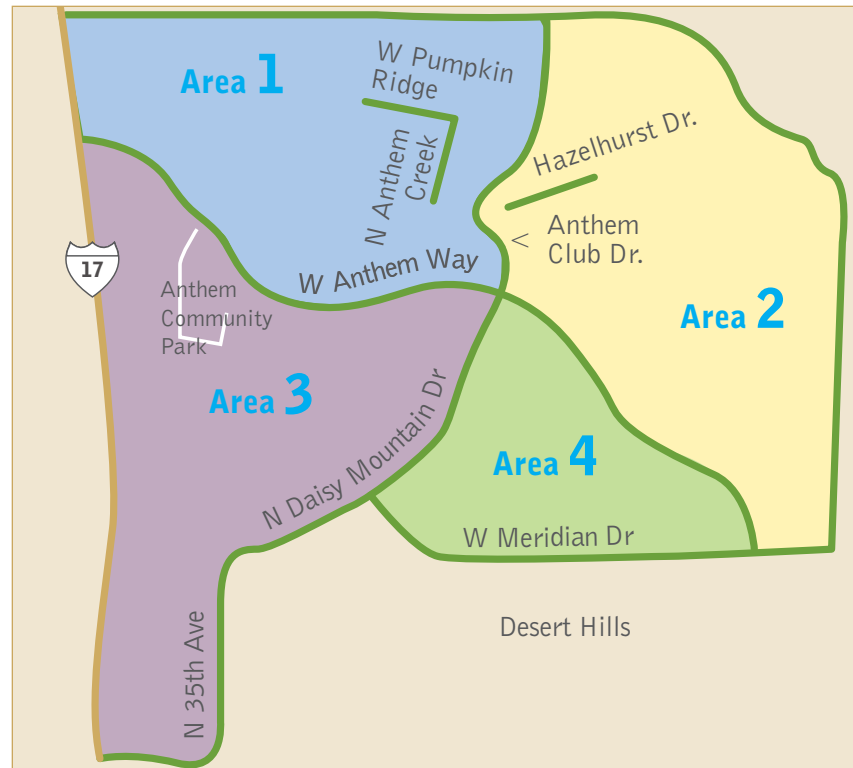
DO NOT PLACE CONTAINER ON THE SIDEWALK!

Recycling Container Collection Guidelines



DO



- **Rinse** plastic containers, steel and tin cans to remove liquid and food, then dry; this will help avoid attracting flies and other pests.
- **Leave** lids on if they are made of recyclable materials.
- **Break down** or cut up large cardboard boxes before placing in container. This prevents material from wedging inside the container, restricting contents from being disposed.
- **Place** junk mail or loose papers in brown paper bags. This prevents spills.
- **Ensure** recyclables are clean and dry.
- **Please** ensure lid of container is closed before placing out for collection.
- **Ensure** that the recycling container lid opens toward the collection vehicle.
- **Deliver** large pieces of cardboard that do not fit into your recycling container to your nearest drop off recycling bin.

DON'T



- **Place** your recycling container near parked cars, light poles, mailboxes, or near other obstacles that could hinder collection.
- **Leave** your recycling container at the curb after 6:00 pm if it has been serviced.
- **Stack** items on or near containers.
- **Leave** inserts in chipboard boxes.
- **Use** your recycling container for garbage.
- **Swap** containers with your neighbor.

* In order to reduce spillage of loose recyclables like junk mail and loose papers, place them in a brown paper bag. **Do not** place recyclables in plastic bags as this makes it difficult to sort the items at the recycling facility.

Recycling — Good to go!

Newspapers, magazines, phone books and all other inserts

Other Paper Materials:

Computer and writing paper, file folders, paper bags, junk mail, shredded paper in clear bags, thermal fax paper, pet food bags

Glass (clean):

Food and beverage containers only

Aluminum & Metal

Beverage:

Cans, tin and food cans, foil food wrappers

Plastic (clean):

Plastic containers with code symbols 1-7, 2-liter soda bottles, detergent bottles, milk jugs, clear food containers

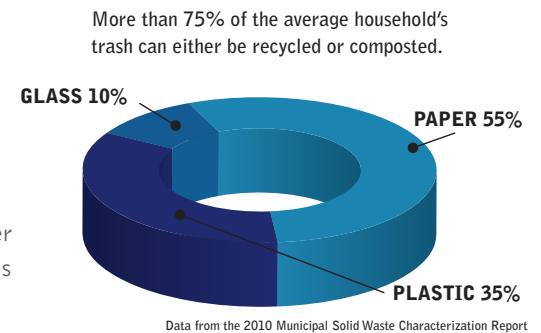
Cardboard/Chipboard:

Corrugated boxes, shoe boxes, soda/beer boxes, dry food boxes such as cereal, cake mix, cracker boxes

Non recyclable - No thanks!

We will be unable to service your recycling container if there are non-recyclable materials in it, so remember, "If it's not on the list, please resist!"

- Wax-covered containers
- Light bulbs
- Pottery
- Window glass
- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam
- Packing peanuts
- 5-gallon buckets
- Facial or toilet paper
- Paper towels/napkins
- Diapers
- Hazardous waste
- Solid waste

Anthem Curbside Recycling

You may ask yourself, what can residents do to increase the amount of recyclables they divert from the landfills? Let's look at some thought provoking facts to put things into perspective.

eWaste: (electronic waste)

- In 2007, 82% equaling 1.8 million tons of ewaste (various electronics e.g. TVs, cell phones, computers etc) ended up in landfills.
- Electronic waste total approximately 2% of the waste stream in the U.S.
- Several states have now created mandatory collection and recycling programs for electronics

Cans:

- Every three months, Americans throw enough aluminum in the landfills to build our nation's entire commercial air fleet.
- The average person has the opportunity to recycle more than 25,000 cans in a lifetime.
- Recycling a single aluminum can saves enough energy to power a TV for three hours.

Cardboard:

- Recycling 1 ton of cardboard saves 46 gallons of oil.
- Over 90% of all products shipped in the U.S. are shipped in corrugated boxes, which totals more than 400 billion square feet of cardboard.
- Nearly 80% of all retailers and grocers recycle their cardboard.

Food Waste: (without paper products)

- Food waste can be used for composting and sold to farmers or it can be provided as a food source for local animal farms that meet federal, state and local regulations for food scrap usage.
- Almost half of the food in the U.S. goes to waste - approximately 3,000 pounds per second.
- Food scraps make up almost 12% of municipal solid waste generated in the U.S.
