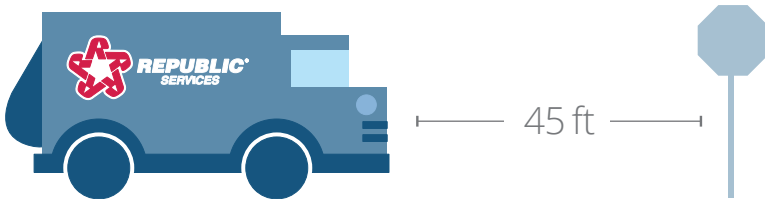


# 4 Tips for Summer Safety

If an average-sized loaded truck is going 25 mph through the neighborhood, it needs about 45 feet to stop. If you're driving behind a truck, put about five seconds worth of space between your car and them.



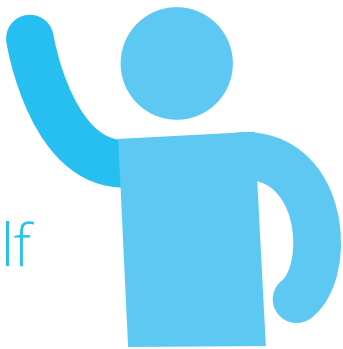
## Know your collection day.
