


4 Tips for Summer Safety

Give trucks space.

If an average-sized loaded truck is going 25 mph through the neighborhood, it needs about 45 feet to stop. If you're driving behind a truck, put about five seconds worth of space between your car and them.





Be mindful of collection vehicles on your neighborhood's recycling and waste days. Always look both ways before entering the street.



Wave and make eye contact with your driver before passing in front of or behind them.

Watch from afar.
