Motor Oil Recycling: Motor oil that is free from contaminants must be placed in a nonbreakable (gallon sized or smaller) container with a tight fitting screw cap lid. **Note:** Plastic milk or bleach jugs work best.

Cooking Oil: Cooking oil that is free from contaminants must be placed in a nonbreakable (gallon sized or smaller) container with a tight fitting screw cap lid. **Note:** Plastic milk or bleach jugs work best.

Place **OIL** containers **ON THE GROUND BESIDE THE CART** or bring to our Recycle Center located at 1749 Merlin Rd.

Fluorescent bulbs: Home Depot will take back (CFL) Compact Fluorescent Light bulbs free of charge. You can bring your fluorescent tubes to our Household Hazardous Waste Event to dispose of them free of charge or recycle them at the JoCo Transfer Station 1749 Merlin Rd. for a small fee.

Glass Jars & Bottles: Glass cannot be placed in the recycling cart as the commingle recycle materials are hand sorted and the glass can break and cut the workers. You can bring your glass jars and bottles to one of our Recycle Centers located at 1920 NW Washington Blvd or 1749 Merlin Rd.



Appliances: Can be recycled at the JoCo Transfer Station 1749 Merlin Rd. for a fee. Appliances that are **FREON FREE** are \$10.00 each and those containing **FREON** are \$25.00 each.

Batteries: Car batteries can be recycled at our Recycle Center located at 1749 Merlin Rd. **Rechargeable batteries** can be recycled for free inside our office located at 1920 NW Washington Blvd. **Non rechargeable batteries** can be brought to our Household Hazardous Waste Event held in September to recycle them for free.
