



Bag all garbage. Keep lid closed. If cart lid is open more than 6", you may be charged extra.

Extras for a fee:

Extras for a fee:

- Put extra yard debris in paper lawn bags or sturdy containers labeled "yard debris."
- Extras will be charged in 32-gallon increments, with each extra equaling 32 gallons.











2023 Calendar (set out carts by 7 a.m.)

Set carts out with handles facing the house. Do not block cars, mailboxes, sidewalks or driveways. Remove carts as soon as possible after collection.

- **Holidays** No service on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. If collection falls mid-week, the collection day will shift one day the rest of the week (i.e. Tuesday collection will occur Wednesday).
- **Recycling** During blue weeks, place your recycling cart curbside next to your garbage cart.
- Food & Yard Waste During green weeks, place your yard and food waste cart curbside next to your garbage cart. $\textbf{Spring/Fall Cleanup} \cdot \textbf{During this week, place extra garbage and yard waste out on your pickup day at no extra}$
- cost. Limited to 10, 32-gallon units for each waste type. More information at **KentWA.gov/TalkingTrash**
- **Recycling Event** Free collection event on March 4, June 3 and October 14. More information at **KentWA.gov/TalkingTrash**
