- ✓ Set carts out by 6 a.m.
- ✓ Remove carts as soon as possible after collection



Bad Weather Conditions

Alerts will be posted at RepublicServices.com/municipality/unincorporated-nkc-wa. If conditions prevent safe collection, up to double the material will be collected on your next regular collection day at no additional charge.

Recycling/Reciclaje

Empty, Clean and Dry

DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES

- NO PLASTIC BAGS OR FILM
- NO SHREDDED PAPER
- NO RESIDUAL FOOD OR LIQUID



Paper

- Empty, clean and dry



Cardboard

- Flatten boxes
- 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft. max.
- Keep dry
- Remove plastic bags



Metal Containers

- Empty, clean and dry



Glass Bottles & Jars

- Empty, clean and dry
- Unbroken
- No lids



Plastic Bottles, Jugs & Tubs

- Empty, clean and dry
- Ignore the number. Recycle by shape – bottles, jugs and tubs only



Compostables/Compostables

Food Scraps and Yard Waste

- Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK

- NO PLASTIC BAGS OR FILM
- NO SHREDDED PAPER
- NO ROCKS, DIRT, BARK, PET WASTE



Plants & Yard Waste

- Branches 4 ft. max.



Fruits & Vegetables

- No stickers



Meat, Bones & Leftovers



Dairy, Eggs & Bread



Food-Soiled Paper

- Uncoated (no shiny paper)



Trash/Basura

- NO HAZARDOUS WASTE
