- ✓ Set carts out by 6 a.m.
- ✓ Remove carts as soon as possible after collection

✓ Empty, clean and dry

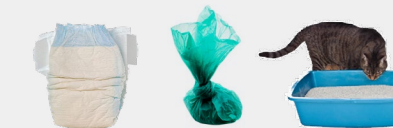

Glass Bottles & Jars

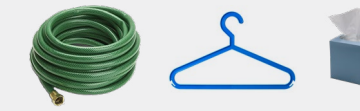
- ✓ Empty, clean and dry
