Expanded recycling for single-family households	Fee	Call to schedule pick-up. 206-777-6441
<b>Large Appliances</b> - Non-CFC containing white goods. Washer/dryer, stove/oven, water heater, etc.	<b>No cost for first 3, \$32.58/each following</b>	3 total appliances per household during contract life at no cost. Any appliances beyond the 3 may be charged fee.
<b>Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners</b>	<b>No cost for first 3, \$48.87/each following</b>	Remove doors from refrigerators and freezers for child safety. 3 total appliances per household during contract life at no cost. Any appliances beyond the 3 may be charged fee.
<b>Large Furniture</b> - sofa, chair, dresser, etc.	<b>\$32.58/ each</b>	
<b>Mattresses</b> - each piece	<b>\$32.58/ each</b>	
<b>Fluorescent tubes and bulbs</b>	<b>Included</b>	Must be wrapped in paper and secured with tape. Limit 2 tubes per collection and 10 tubes per year. Tubes may not be longer than 4'. Place next to recycling cart.
<b>Household batteries</b> - alkaline, button and rechargeable	<b>Included</b>	Place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate, clear, sealed bags.
<b>Rigid plastics</b> - 5 gallon buckets, PVC pipe, laundry baskets, plastic lawn furniture, crates, storage bins, kids pool	<b>Included</b>	Rigid plastic material only. One dimension of the object must be less than 2 ft. Place next to recycling cart.
<b>Scrap metal</b> - bicycle wheels, plumbing pipes, metal shelving, etc.	<b>Included</b>	All ferrous and non-ferrous scrap metal, that is free of wood, plastic, rubber and other contaminants. While smaller scrap metal can be placed in recycling cart, larger items must be called in for pickup. Max. 60 lbs 2 ft.
<b>Small appliances</b> - microwave, toaster, coffee pot, irons, etc.	<b>Included</b>	Limit 2ft x 2ft x 2 ft or smaller and less than 60 lbs. Place next to recycling cart.
<b>Used cooking oil</b> - FOG: fats, oil, grease	<b>Included</b>	Limit 3 gallons per drop-off or pick-up. Limit 10 gallons per year. Seal uncontaminated oil (no large solids) in clean, clear, screw-top plastic jugs. Label jugs with name and address. Place next to recycling cart.
<b>Wood Scraps</b> - clean, unpainted wood, plywood, pallets, dimensional lumber and crates. Some metal fittings and nails allowed	<b>Included</b>	Smaller pieces of material must be placed in a cardboard box next to the recycling container and labeled "Wood Waste". Place larger items, like pallets, next to recycling cart. Limit 4 feet.
