# Composting

Compost yard waste, food scraps & food-soiled paper. No plastic.

- ✓ **No plastic bags**
- ✓ **No rocks, dirt or bark**
- ✓ Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are ok
- ✓ Extra yard waste may be collected in paper bags, 32-gallon cans or boxes 3ft. x 3ft. x 3ft. max. Clearly label as "yard waste." Fees apply.

# Additional Guidelines

## Bad Weather Conditions



If weather conditions prevent safe collection, please remove your carts after 6 p.m. Up to double the material will be collected on your next regular collection day at no additional charge.

## Holiday Schedule

Observed holidays are Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. If your collection day falls on or after that day during the week, your pickup day will shift to the following day (example: Thursday collection will move to Friday, Friday collection will move to Saturday, etc.)

## A Reminder About Proper Container Placement

Please place containers at the curb by 6 a.m. (Do **NOT** block sidewalks)

- Place 2 feet apart with the lids opening toward the street.
- Keep at least 3 feet from cars, trees or mailboxes (our truck arms need clear overhead access to empty containers)
- Please remove containers as soon as possible on your collection day
