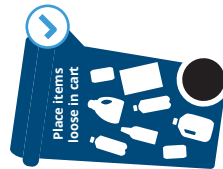

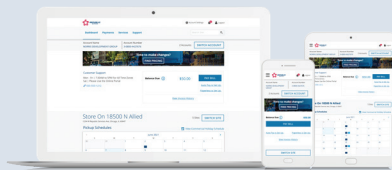

Recycling/Reciclaje

Empty, Clean, Dry

- DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES
- NO RESIDUAL FOOD OR LIQUID
- NO SHREDDED PAPER
- NO PLASTIC BAGS, FILM OR WRAPPERS

Extra Recycling

Max. 60 lbs.

Paper

- Keep dry

Cardboard & Poly-Coated Cartons

- Flatten boxes
- 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft. max.
- Keep dry

Metal Containers

- Empty, clean and dry

Glass Bottles & Jars

- Empty, clean and dry
- Unbroken
- No lids

Plastic Bottles, Jugs & Tubs

- Empty, clean and dry
- Recycle by shape – bottles, jugs, tubs, plastic cups, clamshells, food containers, trays, and plant pots

Compostables/Compostables

Food Scraps & Yard Waste

- Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK
- NO plastic bags

Extra Yard Waste

Max. 60 lbs.

Plants & Yard Waste

- Branches 4 ft. max

Fruits & Vegetables

- No stickers

Meat, Bones & Leftovers

Dairy, Eggs & Bread

Food-Soiled Paper

- Un-coated (no shiny paper)

Trash/Basura

Bag All Trash

- NO HAZARDOUS WASTE
- NO NEEDLES OR SYRINGES
- NO HOT COALS

Extra Trash

Max. 60 lbs.

Mixed Packaging

- Food-soiled
- Wrappers and bags

Polystyrene Foam

- Recycle for free at [StyroRecycle.com](http://StyroRecycle.com)

Diapers & Pet Waste

- Please double-bag pet waste

Household Items

Small Items

- If it's not in the recycling or compostables section, put it in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out!

Do NOT put these items in your cart.

Large Appliances

3 items per household at no cost during contract life. Additional for fee.

Small Appliances

Must be smaller than 2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft. and less than 60 lbs.

Household Batteries

Place in a clear, sealed bag

Used Cooking Oil

Put in plastic jug, and label with name and address. Limit 10 gal./year

Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes

Wrap with paper. Limit 10 tubes per year. Max.4 ft.

Wood Scraps

Clean, unpainted wood scraps. Limit 4 ft.

Rigid Plastics

Scrap Metal

Must be only metal, no other materials. No coatings or grease.
