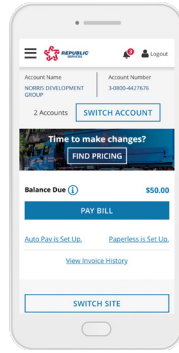

Empty. Clean. Dry.

- ✓ Extra recyclables may be set out in boxes, paper bags or 32-gallon cans marked "recycle" next to the recycling cart
- ✓ Maximum weight is 65 lbs.



No plastic bags



Do not bag recyclables



Food Scraps & Yard Debris

- ✓ Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK
- ✓ No rocks, dirt or sod
- ✓ Extra yard waste may be collected in paper bags, 32-gallon cans, or boxes labeled "yard waste" Maximum of 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft.
- ✓ Maximum weight is 65 lbs.

Garbage

- ✓ No hot coals or ashes
- ✓ Maximum weight is 65 lbs.



Bag all garbage



No hazardous waste



Paper

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry



Plants & Yard Waste

- ✓ Branches 4 ft. max



Mixed Packaging

- ✓ Food-soiled or plastic-coated (anything squishy or clingy)



Cardboard

- ✓ Flatten boxes
- ✓ 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft. max
- ✓ Keep dry



Fruits & Vegetables

- ✓ No stickers



Polystyrene Foam

- ✓ Recycle for free at StyroRecycle in Kent (StyroRecycle.com)



Metal Containers

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry



Meat, Bones & Leftovers



Diapers & Pet Waste

- ✓ Food-soiled or plastic-coated (anything squishy or clingy). Please double-bag pet waste



Glass Bottles & Jars

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry
- ✓ Unbroken
- ✓ No lids

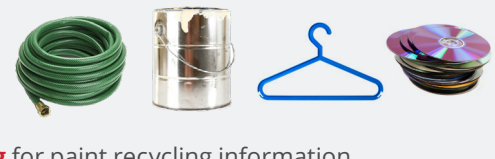


Dairy, Eggs & Bread



Household Items

- ✓ Latex paint cans (dry or empty)
- ✓ Visit Paintcare.org for paint recycling information



Plastic Bottles, Jugs & Tubs

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry



Food-Soiled Paper

- ✓ Uncoated (no shiny paper)



Small Items

- ✓ If it's not in the recycle or compost section, put in trash. When in doubt, throw it out!



2023-2024 Collection Calendar (R2Y1)

Carts must be set out by 6 a.m. Recycling and organics are collected every other week. Garbage is collected weekly. If conditions prevent safe collection, service will resume on the next regular scheduled week. Visit RepublicServicesNW.com for updates.
