RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATES

Rates effective August 1, 2026

A \$ 2.00 per month recycling surcharge will be added to your bill.

This surcharge applies to all residential service types, including will-call and recycling-only service.

Will-Call Service (Less than weekly garbage collection)

Will-Call customers receive: one 32-gallon cart for garbage collection on a per-call basis, up to two 96-gallon carts for regular every-other-week recycling collection, and one red bin for regular every-other-week glass and battery collection. *Urban customers** also receive one 60-gallon cart for regular every-other-week yard debris and food scrap collection

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Program Eligibility Criteria

House with income at or below 185% of the federal poverty level.

Households must be located in unincorporated Washington County.

Program Details:

- The Reduced Rate Program provides a 75% discount on the standard residential can/cart collection rates and the recycling surcharge for qualifying customers.
- Participants receive the reduced rate for a period of 24 months upon program approval.
- Bundled collection services provide garbage, mixed recycling, battery and glass recycling as a bundle. In urban areas, the bundle includes yard debris and food scrap collection.
- Additional services and fees are not included in the Reduced Rate Program.

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ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND FEES

Additional Yard Debris Services

*Includes every-other-week collection of yard debris and food scraps using the hauler-provided 60-gallon cart.
Available to urban* customers only.*

Yard Debris-Only Service: Available to all urban customers who <u>do not</u> already subscribe to <i>Standard Residential Can/Cart Collection Service</i> or is an add-on service for <i>Standard Commercial Can/Cart Collection Service</i> customers.	\$5.27/mon.
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Additional Yard Debris Cart: Available to <i>Standard Can/Cart Collection</i> and <i>Yard Debris-Only</i> customers.	\$4.24/mon.
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Extra Can/Bag/Bundle of Yard Debris: Available to <i>Standard Residential</i> and <i>Yard Debris-Only</i> customers.	\$3.40/each
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Effective October 1, 2023: Residential customers can add food scraps to the yard debris collection cart

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Program Details:

The pick-up fee is applied as a flat rate, regardless of the number of items for disposal. The pick-up fee is billed regardless of whether the item(s) are onsite at the time of agreed upon pick-up. Standard Call Back rates apply if the customer does not set out as directed.

Pick-ups that require extra time due to access issues will be billed for extra labor in five-minute increments, depending on the number of workers required to complete the service.

Contact your garbage company to confirm schedule, availability, and pricing. Items not listed will be billed the Standard Pick-Up Fee and a Cost Per Item Rate based on the size/material type.

Saturday commercial collection service: Customers with service frequency of less than 6 times per week will be charged an additional 6% above the appropriate times-per-week collection rate if they include Saturday collection service. For example, an account that has Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday service will be charged an additional 6% on the appropriate 3 times per week collection rate.

Collection of compacted material: Containers are charged at 2.25 times the loose rate. These rates are based on containers from 1 to 4 yards in size.

Urban Cart Food Scrap Collection: Additional collection pick-up frequency, if available, for 60-65 gallon cart will be charged the standard urban commercial can/cart monthly service rate.

Collection Frequency: A commercial food scraps collection service shall be provided, upon customer request, at either 1 or 2 pick-ups per week. Additional pick-ups may be provided at the service provider's discretion; however, service providers are not required to offer more than 2 per week. Additional collection pick-up frequency, if available, will be charged standard commercial can/cart monthly service rates.

Rural Customer Surcharge: Rural commercial collection rates include a \$2.00 surcharge per pick-up for the first container.

Saturday commercial collection service: Customers with service frequency of less than 6 times per week will be charged an additional 6% above the appropriate times-per-week collection rate if they include Saturday collection service. For example, an account that has Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday service will be charged an additional 6% on the appropriate 3 times per week collection rate.

Collection of compacted material: Containers are charged at 2.25 times the loose rate. These rates are based on containers from 1 to 4 yards in size.

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Commercial Can/Cart Services Rates

Rates effective August 1, 2026

Commercial can/cart service includes weekly garbage collection and every-other-week recycling collection. In urban areas, the bundle includes food scrap collection.

A \$2.00 per month recycling surcharge will be added to your monthly bill.

Additional Compactor and Drop Box Fees and Charges:

Disposal: The actual charge varies by waste type. Disposal is usually charged per ton of material. This fee is then passed on to the customer. The customer may select a disposal site or a processor that best meets their needs.

Fees/Profit Margin: The County fee and the collection company's profit margin are applied to the disposal cost only.

Drop Box Delivery/Set Up Fee: A **\$23.16 fee** assessed on all non-recurring (non-exchange) drop box customers, and to recurring customers for first-time delivery of a drop box. The delivery fee does not apply to compactor or occasional container service.

Mileage: Charged at **\$2.87 per mile** from pick-up of the box/compactor container material to the nearest authorized disposal site by public highway.

Rental: The daily fee applies after two calendar days. *See Administrative Rules Section 8(Q)(d)(3).*

Rental: The daily rental fee applies after two calendar days is **\$3.49 per day**.

Overweight Containers: For penalties assessed on overweight containers. *See Administrative Rules section 8(L)(g).*
