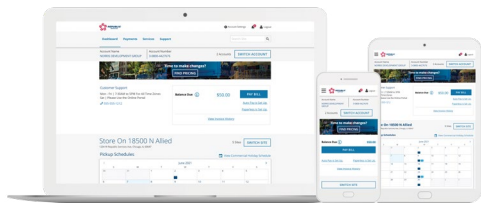
## Cart Placement Guidelines

- ✓ Remove carts as soon as possible after collection
