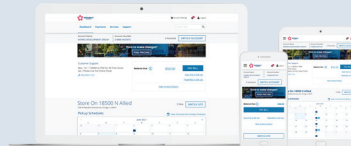

Recycling/Reciclaje

Empty, Clean, Dry

- DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES
- NO FOOD OR LIQUID
- NO SHREDDED PAPER
- NO PLASTIC BAGS, FILM OR WRAPPERS

Extra Recycling

Max. 60 lbs.

Paper

- Keep dry

Cardboard & Poly-Coated Cartons

- Flatten boxes
- 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft. max.
- Keep dry

Metal Containers

- Empty, clean and dry

Glass Bottles & Jars

- Empty, clean and dry
- Unbroken
- No lids

Plastic Bottles, Jugs & Tubs

- Empty, clean and dry
- Recycle by shape – bottles, jugs, plastic cups, clamshells, food containers, tubs, trays

Compostables/Compostables

Food Scraps & Yard Waste

- Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK
- NO rocks, dirt, bark or pet waste
- NO shredded paper
- NO plastic bags

Extra Yard Waste

Max. 60 lbs.

Plants & Yard Waste

- Branches 4 ft. max.

Fruits & Vegetables

- No stickers

Meat, Bones & Leftovers

Dairy, Eggs & Bread

Food-Soiled Paper

- Uncoated (no shiny paper)

Trash/Basura

- Bag All Trash
- NO HAZARDOUS WASTE
- NO LOOSE SHARPS
- NO HOT COALS

Extra trash — fees apply

Max. 60 lbs.

Mixed Packaging

- Food-soiled
- Wrappers and bags

Polystyrene Foam

- Recycle for free at StyroRecycle (StyroRecycle.com)

Diapers & Pet Waste

- Please double-bag pet waste

Household Items

- Bag all vacuum dust
- Bag and tie shredded paper

Small Items

- If it's not in the recycling or compostables section, put it in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out!

Call 206.682.9730 for curbside pickup.
Keep these items outside of the cart.

Large & Small Appliances

Polystyrene

In a clear bag.
No packing peanuts.

Cooking Oil

Put in a clear plastic jug. Label with name and address. Limit 3 gallons per pickup and 10 gallons per year.

OIL

Wood Scraps

Clean, unpainted, untreated. Max. 4 ft.

Household Batteries

Place in a clear, sealed bag.

Textiles

Place in a clear bag.

Fluorescent Bulbs & Tubes

Wrap tubes in newspaper. Limit 2 tubes per collection/10 per year. 4 ft. max.

Rigid Plastics

Scrap Metal

Must be all metal. No coatings or grease. While smaller pieces can be placed inside trash carts, larger scrap metal items will need to be called in for curbside pickup.
