



**Unincorporated South King County (excluding Kent, Covington, Auburn, Renton, Petrovitsky) Residential Rates – effective as of January 1, 2026**

Effective January 1, 2026, Republic Services' solid waste rates in the King County Unincorporated areas will increase to reflect Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustments, the King County landfill disposal increase and B&O tax increase. (Per Appendix A under the WA Utilities Tariff 26)

Note: Cart lids must be fully closed. If cart lids are not fully closed additional charges for extras will occur.

Recycling (every other week service )	Monthly Rate for Every Other Week Service (mandatory charge billed quarterly)	Do NOT bag recycling.
One 32 or 96-gallon cart	\$12.15	Recycled materials must be empty, clean & dry. No plastic bags.
Extra recycling	Included	Box, bundle or bag in paper bags, label "recycling" and place next to recycle cart.
Recycling only (no garbage service)	\$13.28	

Compost - food scraps and yard debris (every other week service)	Monthly Rate for Every Other Week Service (billed quarterly)	Special Preparation
Maximum 3 containers up to 96 -gallons per container or 3 lifts per pickup.	\$14.32	No plastic bags. No treated wood. No rocks, dirt or bark.
Food Scraps/Yard Waste Only (96 gallon)	\$18.86	
Extra yard waste (32-gallon bag/bundle/can)	\$6.43 per 32 gal unit	Bag in Kraft type paper bags, 32-gallon lidded can (65 lb limit), or bundles tied with twine (4' x 2' limit). NO food scraps outside of cart. Label "yard waste" and place next to compost cart.

Bear-resistant unlocking fee	\$4.16 per month/cart	*applies to rented and customer owned carts. *customer owned cans may not be larger than 32 gallons.
Return Trips - applies to cans, units	\$12.83 per trip (\$17.64 for recycling containers)	When company is required to return to pickup that was unavailable for collection for reasons under the customer control.
Carry-out Fee - applies to cans, units	\$1.46 per month up to 25 ft and \$1.46 for each additional 25 ft.	Fee applies to cans/units carried out over 5 feet but not over 25 ft.
Redelivery Fee - applies to company owned can or carts	\$18.67	A redelivery fee will be assessed to customers whose cart or company owned can was picked up because service was discontinued for non-payment or customers who request re-delivery or exchange or container sizes.
Over-sized or Over-weight - applies to can, unit, bag	\$5.45 per unit/each pickup	If the receptacle exceeds the size and/or limits.
Drive-in charge	\$9.63 per month	Charged for drive-ins on driveways over 125 ft per container.
