California Assembly Bill 1826 (AB 1826), also known as the Mandatory Commercial Organics Recycling (MORE) law, became fully effective January 1, 2016. AB 1826 requires that all commercial businesses, including multi-family dwellings of 5 units or more, that generate two (2) cubic yards or more of solid waste per week have an organics recycling program. Solid waste includes the total amount of waste from trash, recycling and organic waste. Organic waste includes food waste and yard/green waste. An organics recycling program can include collection by a third-party contractor, donating, self-hauling or sharing waste services with another business.
