



Commercial Waste Collection Services Guide

Fremont businesses are required to keep recyclables like cardboard, paper, bottles, and cans as well as compostables like food scraps, food-soiled paper and plant trimmings out of the landfill. These regulations are intended to conserve natural resources and reduce greenhouse gases.

Mandatory Recycling and Composting

To be in compliance with the State and local regulations, all businesses must:

- Have Recycle service
- Have Compost service
- Subscribe to sufficient size and frequency of Recycle and Compost services
- Set up proper indoor bins and signage
- Properly separate materials

Posters, Signs & Decals

What's Required

- Subscribe to 3 services at sufficient levels:
 Landfill, Recycle, and Compost*
- Place color-coded and labeled Recycle and Compost bins next to all Landfill bins
- Separate all Recycle, Compost, and Landfill items into the appropriate containers
- Educate employees, contractors, and tenants about the law at least annually and check bins periodically to ensure proper sorting
- Certain large, food-generating businesses are required by State and local laws to donate edible food that would otherwise be disposed. For more information on business requirements, go to StopWaste.org/Rules
- * Sites with minimal amounts of food scraps, compostable paper, and plant waste may qualify for a compost service waiver. More info: StopWaste.org/Rules
