

California Recycling Legislation: Assembly Bill (AB) 341 and Senate Bill (SB) 1383

- ▶ **AB 341 (Mandatory Commercial Recycling):** Effective July 1, 2012, this law requires businesses generating 4+ cubic yards of solid waste per week and multi-family dwellings with 5+ units to implement a recycling program for traditional recyclables.
- ▶ **SB 1383 (California's Mandatory Organics Recycling Law):** All residents, businesses and multi-family dwellings are required to divert organics from the landfill through weekly organics collection service and/or donations via food recovery programs.

Recycling and Organics: What Goes Where?

✓ Accepted in the Recycling Cart (Empty, Clean and Dry)



- ✓ **Paper:** Paperback books, flattened boxes, carbonless paper, cardboard (must fit in cart)
- ✓ **Metal:** Aluminum cans and foil, clean food and steel cans
- ✓ **Glass:** Rinsed bottles, jars, CRV beverage containers (any color)
- ✓ **Plastic:** Rinsed containers, detergent bottles, CRV beverage containers, food containers (no Styrofoam™)

✓ Accepted in the Organics Cart



- ✓ **Yard Waste:** Leaves, grass, weeds, brush, flowers and tree trimmings (twigs and branches less than 4 ft.)
- ✓ **Food scraps:** Fruits, veggies, dairy, bread, grains, pasta, meat and seafood (including bones), processed foods (remove packaging)
- ✓ **Untreated wood and wood shavings**

✗ Common Contaminants (Accepted in the Trash Cart)

- ✗ Styrofoam™, clothing, plastic bags, pet waste (cat litter/dog bags), palm fronds and plastic shippers/packaging (used by major online retailers)

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)



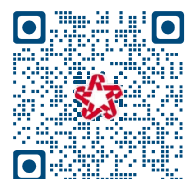
Hazardous waste cannot be collected with your regular pickup service. You must take these items to a facility that can safely dispose of these materials. Placing them in regular service will lead to an interruption in service, until the material is removed.

Fresno County Environmental Compliance Center at 1327 West Dan Ronquillo Drive, Fresno, CA 93706 offers HHW drop-off for residents and businesses.

Residential HHW: (Free/no-cost) - Thursdays through Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. No appointment needed.

Business Hazardous Waste: Pay for cost of disposal (conditionally exempt small quantity generators [CESQG]). Appointment required. Call **877.235.3005** toll-free, for an appointment and a free cost estimate.

Fresno County Unincorporated Annual Drop-Off Event for 2026

The Fresno County On-Call Coupon Program has transitioned to a county-funded community cleanup drop-off event, and Republic Services is offering Unincorporated Fresno County residents the opportunity to dispose of large items and certain appliances at no cost during an upcoming cleanup event for your area. Residents of Unincorporated Fresno County must provide a county-issued coupon at the event to participate at no charge. Residents without a coupon may be responsible for the cost of disposal. Call the Fresno County Resources Division at **559.600.4259** to request a coupon before your scheduled date.

Republic Services has scheduled drop-off dates for your neighborhood at the Rice Road Transfer Station, located at 10463 N. Rice Road, Fresno, CA 93730 (off of Highway 41 and Friant Ave.), from 8:30 a.m. - 2 p.m. Call our office at **559.275.1551** if you have questions about your scheduled date.

What Is Accepted at the Drop-Off Site

Unincorporated Fresno County residents can drop off a maximum of two (2) cubic yards of waste, including white goods and electronic waste. This is approximately equal to the back of a full-size pickup truck, level with the top of the bed. Residents may also drop off one (1) Freon®-containing appliance (refrigerator or freezer) and three (3) mattresses at no cost. 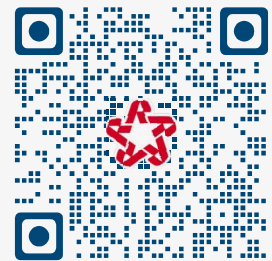
