Before tossing unwanted items, consider if they can be donated or sold to a local thrift store or through an online community group such as Freecycle, Nextdoor, Facebook Marketplace, or Buy Nothing group. If your item is damaged, consider if it can be repaired. The good news is there are many ways we can reduce the waste that goes to landfills. Our goal is to reduce the amount of waste

# Remember to Compost Your Food Waste!

Cooked meat and bones, leftovers, fruit, vegetables and even pumpkins (unpainted and candles removed) should all be placed in your yard waste cart.





## **Holiday Tree Recycling**

Holiday tree collection will occur on your collection day from **December 26, through January 15, 2026**.
Before placing trees out for recycling, remember to:

 Remove stands, lights, tinsel, ornaments and other decorations

- Cut trees into 4-foot lengths
- Put trees at designated area for large multi family properties that is coordinated by property manager
- Flocked or tinted trees will be collected but not composted
- Property managers, please discuss the designated area with your sustainability advisors. Areas that are not pre-approved will not be serviced

After January 15, trees must be cut to fit completely inside your Compost cart.

# Holiday Decorations You Can Compost

Here's a few reminders of what can go inside your green Compost cart during the holidays.

Natural Wreaths, Garland, Holly & Mistletoe
Remove wire frames, hangers, wires, and
decorations first and place them in your
garbage if they can't be saved and reused
next year.

- Poinsettias & Other Plants
   Remove pots first and any ribbons or other decorations.
- Wooden Tree Stands
   Remove plastic buckets and nails.
