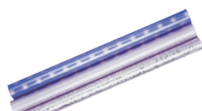

Flocked, Artificial and Wrapped Trees: Not Recyclable or Compostable

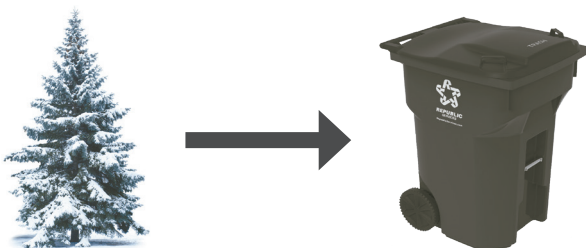
Flocked or artificial trees can be cut to size to fit in the **black waste cart** with the lid closed.

If you are unable to cut down your tree to fit in your cart:

Call **800.320.8077** to schedule a curbside pickup.

There will be a fee of **\$34.66** to pick up and dispose non-compostable trees.

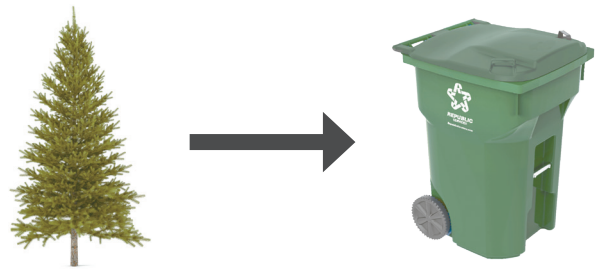
In lieu of the **\$34.66 fee**, you may use one of your annual Curbside Bulk Item Cleanups for non-compostable and non-recyclable Christmas trees. To be collected curbside, non-compostable and non-recyclable Christmas trees must be cut so that pieces are no longer than 4 feet.



Compostable Treecycling and Disposal Options

Natural, unflocked Christmas trees are compostable and will be collected curbside December 26, 2025 - January 10, 2026.

- Remove everything from the tree, including the tinsel and stand.
- Trim or cut the tree to size, and place it in your green organics cart, or
- Place the tree curbside on your regular service day. If trees are more than 6 feet tall, please cut them in half.



Important Guidelines for Compostable Christmas Trees

Remove all lights, ornaments, tinsel, nails and stands. No flocked, painted, fireproof or artificial trees, or trees contaminated with decorations, stands or plastic/cloth wrappings. If trees are more than 6 feet tall, please cut them in half.
