Cart Options

Republic Services offers different cart sizes to best fit your recycling and waste needs year-round: 32-gallon, 65-gallon or 95-gallon carts.

PLACING CARTS FOR COLLECTION

- ▶ Face carts toward the street with wheels against the curb or gutter the night before or by 7 a.m. on your scheduled service day.
- ▶ Allow at least 3 feet between carts and 6 feet between carts and other objects (mailboxes, trees, basketball hoops, cars, etc.).
- ▶ Make sure lids are securely shut. Materials should not extend beyond the cart rim.
- ▶ Do not place hot ashes, dirt, rocks, concrete or hazardous items in your carts.

REASONS WASTE MAY NOT BE COLLECTED

- Overfilled or overweight cart
- ▶ Insufficient space to service cart
- ▶ Cart too far from curb
- ▶ Car blocking cart
- ▶ Unacceptable material in cart

Holidays

Republic Services observes the following holidays:

Know What to Throw

When it comes to the blue recycling carts, always remember to keep materials empty, clean and dry.

Tips for recycling:

- ▶ Aim to recycle clean materials that are not contaminated with food, oil, etc.
- If you are recycling cardboard, break down boxes so that they are flat. This will save you space in your cart for other recyclable materials and prevent overflowing carts.
- Make sure all liquids or other contents are removed from bottles or jugs.
- Never bag your recycling! Make sure all recyclables are LOOSE when they reach the carts that are serviced by our drivers.
- ▶ Refer to the list of recyclable items listed in this brochure if unsure.
