

Notice of Non-Compliance State of California's Mandatory Commercial Organics Law (AB 1826)

February 1, 2021

Dear Business Owner or Manager:

Assembly Bill (AB) 1826 requires businesses that generate organic waste to arrange for recycling services for that waste. On September 15, 2020, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) lowered the AB 1826 threshold to include businesses that generate two or more cubic yards per week of solid waste (total of garbage, recyclables and organics). Based on the new threshold, our records indicate your business may be out of compliance with AB 1826. To comply with this State law, your business must arrange for organic waste recycling. Organic waste includes food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, non-hazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper.
