Anything **not listed** below is acceptable for *residential, commercial, and industrial customers*. For more information, please call Customer Service at 1-800-700-8610.

- Barrels - unless rinsed and/or empty with both ends cut off
- Batteries
- Cars, Trucks, Motor Homes, Busses (No Vehicles)
- Corrosive Waste
- Empty tanks - gas, oil, fuel, unless rinsed and/or empty and cut in half
- Flammable Waste
- Fluorescent light tubes
- Hazardous Waste
- Liquids
- Medical Waste
- Paint (can accept if dry or hardened)
- Radioactive waste
- Reactive Waste
- Septic Waste
- Sewage treatment plant solids
- Tires
- Used Oils - motor, hydraulic, mineral, cutting, etc.
- White Goods/Appliances - Refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc.

Recycling items

Applicable to residential and commercial accounts. For more information, please call Customer Service at 1-800-700-8610.

ACCEPTABLE: Aerosol Cans (empty only), Aluminum & Tin Cans, Aluminum Foil, Cardboard, Cereal Boxes (without lining), Drink Boxes, Egg Cartons, Foam Cups & Plates, Glass Bottles & Jars, Juice Cartons, Junk Mails & Brochures, Laundry Bottles, Magazines, Newspapers, Plastic Bottles & Containers, Plastic Bags, Plastic Milk Jugs, Phone Books, Wrapping Paper, Files & Folders, Mixed Waste Paper & Catalogs, Paper or Frozen Food Boxes, Paper Bags, Flattened Cardboard

NOT ACCEPTABLE: Waxed & Carbon Paper, Food & Liquid Waste (Soiled Materials), Solid Waste & Yard Waste, Hazardous E-Waste

NOTES: all recyclables must be empty, clean, and dry TM

Yard waste

Applicable to residential and commercial accounts. For more information, please call Customer Service at 1-800-700-8610.

ACCEPTABLE: Grass & Leaves (loose, not bagged); Pruning & Weeds; Twigs & Small Branches (four inches or less in diameter and two feet or less in length); Vegetations (from the yard & kitchen)

NOT ACCEPTABLE: Animal & Food Waste, Construction Debris, Dirt & Rocks, Palm Fronds, Plastic Bags, Rugs, Flooring & Metal, Recyclable & Solid Waste, Hazardous Waste

NOTES: 4 inches or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in length, do not put yard waste in plastic bags

Appliance

Applicable to residential and commercial accounts

ACCEPTABLE: Water Heaters, Refrigerator, Freezers, A/C Units

NOT ACCEPTABLE: N/A

NOTES: must be placed at curbside, all refrigerators and freezer doors must be taped shut or removed for safety when being disposed of

Bulk

Applicable to residential and commercial accounts

ACCEPTABLE: Washers, Dryer, Stoves, BBQ grills, Lawnmowers, Furniture, Beds, Sofa, Chairs, Wood, Fish Tanks, Mirrors or Glass (must be taped)

NOT ACCEPTABLE: Animal carcasses, Asbestos, Ash, Automobiles or car parts, Bio-hazardous medical waste, Camper Shells, Cast Iron Bathtubs, Chemical and/or petroleum cleanup waste, Compressed cylinders, Construction and demolition debris, Drums, tanks, kegs and barrels (plastic and metal) , Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG), Fencing/sheds/gazebos, Paint, Mattress with Bed Bugs, Medical Beds, Medical Sharps, Piano, Propane Tanks, Radioactive material, Riding lawnmowers, Shingles, roofing materials, Soil, rocks, grubbing material and spoil, Spas

NOTES: must be placed at curbside

Construction debris

Not applicable to residential and commercial accounts. For more information, please call Customer Service at 1-800-700-8610.

Electronics recycling

Applicable to residential accounts

ACCEPTABLE: TV, Computers, Monitors, Microwaves, Copiers, Fax Machine, Stereo

NOT ACCEPTABLE: N/A

NOTES: must be placed at curbside, for orange county residents - electronics are also available for drop-off at the Household Hazardous Waste Facilities

Medication Disposal

Do not flush unused medications and do not pour them down a sink or drain – unless the label or accompanying patient information instructs you to do so.
