Why Separating Your Organics Matters

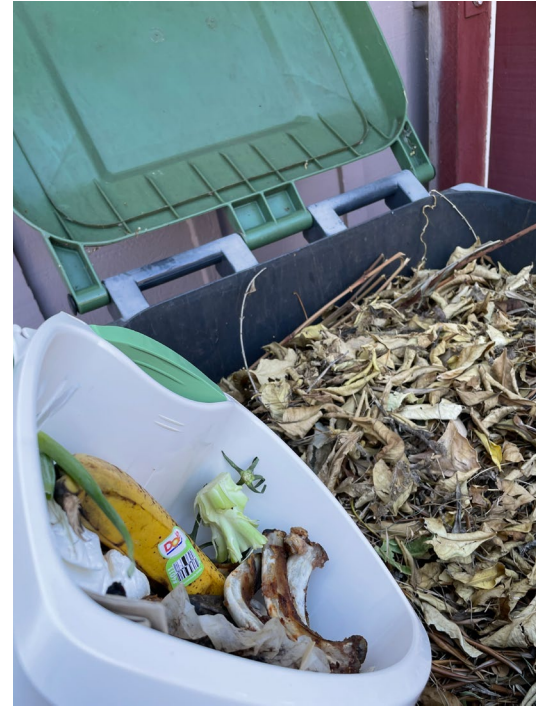
Did you know that placing your food scraps and yard trimmings in your organics cart (green lid cart) helps protect our environment? It's a small everyday action with a big impact!

When you use your organics cart, your waste goes to a compost facility instead of a landfill. There, it's turned into nutrient-rich compost used for farming and landscaping. This helps:

- ▶ Reduce harmful greenhouse gasses, like methane emissions, and helps limit climate change, which causes hotter summers, more intense wildfires and increasingly unpredictable weather.
- ▶ Keep valuable materials out of the landfill.
- ▶ Support healthier soil and local agriculture.

California's Senate Bill (SB) 1383 law requires everyone to separate organics to help reduce climate warming emissions. Help improve our recycling and organics program by placing only acceptable materials in your recycling and organics carts. Proper sorting will also help our customers avoid contamination fees.

By using your organics cart correctly, you're helping create a cleaner, healthier community for everyone. Thank you for doing your part!

Free compost is available to Suisun City residents at compost giveaway events. These events are held annually on the first Saturday of April and September. The next Suisun City compost event is Saturday, September 5, 9 a.m. – noon, or while supplies last.

Suisun City Residents: Don't Forget to Schedule Your FREE Bulk Waste Pickup

Each household is offered one free bulk waste pickup per year. The free bulk waste pickup includes up to 3 cubic yards of trash and two bulk waste items (sofas, mattresses, large appliances).

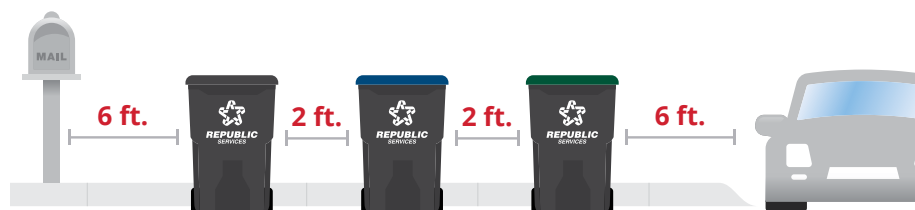
- ▶ Bulk items may be collected by different trucks, depending on the materials you need to dispose of. For example, if your pickup consists of one mattress and one appliance, you will have two different trucks picking up these items.
- ▶ There is a charge for Freon® removal and for cathode ray tubes (CRTs).

It's Easy to Schedule!

- ▶ Have everything ready: small or loose items need to be placed in a bag or box, or be bundled for collection, and must weigh less than 50 pounds.
- ▶ Call Republic Services at **707.437.8900** to schedule your free bulk waste pickup.
- ▶ Place items on the curb before 6 a.m. on the designated collection date.

Please place carts at least 2 feet apart and 6 feet away from other objects, such as cars, mailboxes and light poles.



Appliance Events (White Goods)

Republic Services will accept appliances from Suisun City residents with a valid residential waste account on the following Friday and Saturday dates in 2026: April 10 - 11 and 24 - 25; June 12 - 13; July 10 - 11; August 7 - 8; September 11 - 12; and October 9 - 10.



Drop-Off Location:

Republic Services, 2901 Industrial Court, Fairfield, CA, Friday, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. (closed 11:45 a.m. - 1 p.m. and Saturday, 9 a.m. - noon).

*Proof of residency is required.

Electronic Waste (E-Waste)

Suisun City residents can drop off small appliances and electronic waste at the Republic Services facility located at 2901 Industrial Court, Fairfield, CA. The facility is open from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday - Friday (closed for lunch from 11:45 a.m. - 1 p.m. daily).

The electronic waste weight limit is 60 pounds. Customers can bring up to five items per visit. All batteries must be removed from electronic devices. Medical equipment is not accepted.
