Handling Your Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Do you have some paint left over from your last DIY project, or have other household chemicals that you don't need anymore? Keep the environment safe from household hazardous waste (HHW). It's free for Suisun City residents to dispose of these items. Republic Services' HHW facility is open the second and fourth Saturday of January through October and the first and third Saturday in November and December. Proof of residency is required, and it is by appointment only. For all dates, the HHW facility is open from 9 a.m. – noon. Please call the HHW hotline at **707.437.8971** for more information and registration assistance.



| ACCEPTABLE HHW ITEMS | |

| PAINT | Oil and latex paints, stains, varnishes, solvents, thinners and adhesives |
| AUTOMOTIVE ITEMS | Motor oil, oil filters, contaminated motor oil, antifreeze, gasoline and batteries |
| CHEMICALS | Household: oven cleaners, drain cleaners, bleach, sprays, waxes and polishes Garden: pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, ant trap poison and gopher bait Other: pool chemicals, photographic chemicals, flammable liquids/gases, aerosol cans, roofing tar and roofing products |
| FLUORESCENT LIGHTS | Tubes, bulbs and other mercury-containing lamps |
| BATTERIES | AA, AAA, C and D cells and button batteries |
| MERCURY GAUGES | Barometers, manometers and old thermostats |
| NEEDLES | Must be placed in a clear, rigid-enclosed container with the lid taped closed to prevent spilling |

No single container larger than 5 gallons will be accepted. The maximum allowable quantity is 15 gallons or 125 pounds per trip. This a partial list of HHW items. Please contact Republic Services at **707.437.8971** for more information.

Electronic Waste

Suisun City residents can drop off small appliances and electronic waste at the Republic Services facility located at 2901 Industrial Court, Fairfield, CA. The facility is open from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., Monday – Friday (closed for lunch from 11:45 a.m.- 1 p.m.)

The electronic waste weight limit is 60 pounds. Customers can bring up to 5 items per visit. All batteries must be removed from electronic devices. Medical equipment is not accepted.

Used Oil Curbside

Used motor oil and oil filters are picked up curbside free in special Republic Services jugs and bags. Place jugs and bagged filters next to your recycling cart (blue lid). Do not place in cart.

To request jugs and bags, call customer service at **707.437.8900**. No other containers are accepted. We will replace the full jug with a clean one.

Appliance Events (White Goods)

Republic Services will accept appliances from Suisun City residents with a valid residential waste account on the following Friday and Saturday dates: August 8-9, September 12-13 and October 17-18. Proof of residency is required. Limit of 2 per customer.

Suisun City Residents: Don't Forget to Schedule Your 2025 FREE Bulk Waste Pickup

Each household has one free bulk waste pickup per year. The free bulk waste pickup includes:

- ▶ Up to 3 cubic yards of bulk waste materials
- ▶ 2 bulk waste items (sofas, mattresses, large appliances)

There is a charge for Freon® removal and for computer monitors and CRTs (cathode ray tubes).

It's Easy to Schedule!

- Have everything ready: small or loose items need to be placed in a bag or box, or be bundled for collection, and must weigh less than 50 pounds.
- ► Call Republic Services at **707.437.8900** to schedule your free bulk waste pickup.
- ▶ Place items on the curb before 6 a.m. on the designated collection date.

Please Help Us Serve You Better

Please place carts at least 2 feet apart and 6 feet away from other objects, such as cars, mailboxes and light poles. **NOTE: We cannot service carts that are placed next to or under basketball hoops that are curbside.**



BOPA Facility

Residents can take batteries, oil (motor and cooking), paint (latex), and antifreeze to the BOPA collection facility.

2901 Industrial Court, Fairfield, CA

8 a.m. to 4 p.m. (closed 11:45 a.m. - 1 p.m., Monday - Friday) *Proof of residency is required.*

Restrictions: The maximum quantity allowed is 5 gallons of latex paint, 5 gallons of motor oil, 3 pounds of household batteries and 3 car batteries per resident per month. Oil and antifreeze must be in a sealed clear container.
