Free Indoor Food Scraps Bins

Free indoor bins are available to qualifying Alameda County businesses for the collection of food scraps, compostable paper and plant debris ("organics"). A variety of containers and lids are available—up to a value of \$500 per approved site including tax and delivery.

Reuse is best!



Before tossing unwanted items that are in good condition, consider if they can be donated or sold to a local thrift store or through an online community group such as Freecycle, Nextdoor, Facebook Marketplace, or Buy Nothing group. If your item is damaged, consider if it can

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Small Business Hazardous Waste Service

Alameda County offers this service for businesses, organizations, and agencies to drop off small amounts of hazardous waste safely and affordably. Due to Federal and State hazardous waste laws, businesses cannot participate in the Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Residential Drop-off Service.

To use this service, complete the following steps:

1. Provide an EPA Hazardous Waste Identification Number. If you don't already have one, visit: dtsc.ca.gov and search "Apply for a Hazardous Waste EPA ID Number" or call **800-618-6942**.
2. Apply for an account with the HHW Program and qualify as a Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG).
3. Make an appointment by calling Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste at **800-606-6606**. Businesses must have an account before making appointments.

Business Hazardous Waste Drop-in Service

All businesses in Alameda County can participate in this drop-in service that accepts latex paint, aerosol cans, fluorescent lamps, and household batteries. There is no need to set up an account or make an appointment.
