#### Small Business Hazardous Waste Service

Alameda County offers this service for businesses, organizations, and agencies to drop off small amounts of hazardous waste safely and affordably. Due to Federal and State hazardous waste laws, businesses cannot participate in the Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Residential Drop-off Service.

#### To use this service, complete the following steps:

- Provide an EPA Hazardous Waste Identification Number. If you don't already have one, visit: dtsc.ca.gov and search "Apply for a Hazardous Waste EPA ID Number" or call 800-618-6942.
- 2. Apply for an account with the HHW Program and qualify as a Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG).
- 3. Make an appointment by calling Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste at **800-606-6606**. Businesses must have an account before making appointments.

#### **Business Hazardous Waste Drop-in Service**

All businesses in Alameda County can participate in this drop-in service that accepts latex paint, aerosol cans, fluorescent lamps, and household batteries. There is no need to set up an account or make an appointment.
