## Sustainable Fall Cleaning

A Bulky Item Collection may be requested by your property manager for a fee to collect unwanted items that are too large or bulky. Set aside reusable and recyclable items to ensure these are collected for reuse and recycling and not sent to the landfill. Alternatively, the property manager may request an open-top debris box for a property-organized clean-up event for the associated container collection rate.

## Reuse is best!

Before tossing unwanted items, consider if they can be donated or sold to a local thrift store or through an online community group such as Freecycle, Nextdoor, Facebook Marketplace, or Buy Nothing group. If your item is damaged, consider if it can be repaired. The RE:Source guide has handy information on reuse, repair, recycling and safe disposal. Haven't tried using the RE:Source guide yet? Don't let a moldy pumpkin scare you — it's still compostable! Remove any candles or decorations, and simply put it in your green cart. Pumpkins collected through the compost program will be transformed into compost, which can be used to nourish plants and trees.




## RECYCLE

### YES

All clean cardboard, paper, glass, metal & plastics marked  should be placed in the gray recycle cart or white recycle bin

### NO

Plastic bags or containers labeled , hoses & wires, compostable materials, household hazardous waste, pumpkins, and holiday tree lights.



## COMPOST

### YES

All food scraps, food-soiled paper, BPI-certified compostable products, pumpkins, all yard trimmings and untreated wood should be placed in the green compost bin/cart.

### NO

Non-compostable plastics, personal hygiene products, treated wood, recyclable materials, household hazardous waste.
