Sustainable Spring Cleaning: Bulky Item Collection Service

A bulky item collection may be requested by your property manager for a fee to collect unwanted items that are too large or bulky. Set aside reusable and recyclable items to ensure these are collected for reuse and recycling and not sent to the landfill. Alternatively, the property manager may request an open-top debris box for a property-organized clean-up event for the associated container collection rate.

Beginning in April 2025, carts and bins at multi-family properties will be exchanged to comply with State and local laws regarding color coding of containers.* To reduce confusion and promote proper waste sorting, State and local laws require black or gray landfill containers, blue recycle containers and green compost containers. Acceptable in your compost cart/bin:

All Food Scraps: Fruits, Vegetables, Meat, Seafood, Bones, Shells, Dairy & Bread. Yard Trimmings & Untreated Wood. Coffee Grounds, Tea Leaves, Paper Filters & Teabags. Food/Grease-Soiled Paper.



Pro tip: Line your kitchen pail with paper towels, newspaper, kraft paper, or egg cartons to keep it tidy. Plastic bags are prohibited. Visit StopFoodWaste.org to Learn How to Reduce Food Waste.

Acceptable in your recycle cart/bin:

Cardboard & Mixed Paper. Paper Boxes. Metal Cans, Scrap & Trays. Glass Bottles & Jars. Plastic Bottles. Rigid Plastic Containers 1–2.



Keep Recyclables Clean, Dry and Empty.
Do Not Bag Items.

Acceptable in your landfill cart/bin:

Lined Food & Beverage Cartons & Pouches. Plastic Bags & Shrink Wrap. Plastics 3–7 & Plastic Utensils. Styrofoam Products. Broken Glassware & Ceramics. Diapers, Pet Waste & Personal Hygiene Products. Hoses & Wires. Other Household Items.



Non-Recyclable and Non-Compostable Items Only.
Eliminate Single-Use Plastic Waste by Choosing Durable, Reusable Products.

Reuse is best!

Before your collection of unwanted items that are in good condition, consider if they can be donated or sold to a local thrift store or through an online community group such as Freecycle, Nextdoor, Facebook Marketplace, or Buy Nothing group. If your item is damaged, consider if it can be repaired. The RE:Source guide available at StopWaste.org has handy information on reuse, repair, recycling and safe disposal.
