Special Recycling Programs

It is ILLEGAL to put any of these items in your carts:

Motor Oil. Call Republic Services at (925) 685-4711 to request a used oil collection container. Then simply place your sealed container and oil filters next to your carts on your collection day.

Medical injection devices (sharps) require special handling and disposal, and cannot be placed in trash or recycling. For disposal instructions and free, local drop-off locations, visit: recyclesmart.org/HHW.

Unused medications shouldn't be tossed in the toilet or trash. Instead, place your prescriptions and over-the-counter medicines into a sealed plastic bag and take them to your local police or sheriff's station. For a complete list of drop-off locations, visit: recyclesmart.org/HHW.



Home composting is an inexpensive and natural process that transforms your yard trimmings and food scraps into a soil amendment for your garden. RecycleSmart offers home composting workshops, discounts on composting bins and a monthly savings on your garbage bill. For more information go to: recyclesmart.org/composting.

Food scraps and soiled paper items can go into your green organics cart. A food scrap container is also





Cart Setout Instructions

Set carts on the street next to the curb and away from vehicles. Place carts out by 6 am on your collection day.



Place all Household batteries, Cell phones, and Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFL's) in a sealed plastic zip lock bag(s). Place batteries and cell phones on top of the blue recycling cart and place CFL's next to your blue recycling cart on your collection day.

You can switch your 64 gallon blue recycling cart and/or green organics cart to a larger 96 gallon size at no extra cost!

Remember: Republic Services is proactively evaluating the need to adjust to changes in recycling markets. Here is how you can help:



Empty. Remove any remaining food or liquid contents from your recyclable item before placing it in a recycling



Clean. Lightly rinse the recyclable item to remove any remaining residue.
