Dear Canyon Customer:

On Friday, May 2nd and Saturday, May 3rd, four 20-yard debris boxes will be available for you to drop off cleanup material. Two boxes will be located by the old railroad tracks near the recycling dumpsters, and the other two will be located near the storage tanks by Driveway 35.

IMPORTANT CLEANUP REMINDERS: *Please do not leave material outside the box.* The box will remain open until it is full. See lists of acceptable and unacceptable items below. If you have any questions, please call Claire Dakhliya, 925-500-3797 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Small furniture such as chairs, end tables and lamps
Swamp coolers
Yard trimmings
Trash

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Large furniture (couches, armoires and beds)
Freon appliances (air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators)
Large appliances (microwave ovens, stoves, ovens, water heaters, clothes washers and dryers) Electronics (cell phones, computers, TVs etc.)
Rocks, dirt, sod, concrete, sheetrock, large clay pots full of dirt, etc.
Large car parts (transmission blocks, engines, etc.)
Pesticides, cleaners or hazardous wastes such as car batteries, latex paint and motor oil*
Medical waste (sharps, needles)
Dead animals
Tires
Mattresses/box springs

Please consider donating items before throwing them away. Consider donating to a local thrift store or placing free advertisements on www.FreeCycle.org or www.Craigslist.org.

Please place trash and yard trimmings in disposable bags, boxes or containers.
