
What is **SB** 1383?

In September 2016, Governor Brown signed into law SB 1383, establishing methane emissions reduction targets in a statewide effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants (SLCP) in various sectors of California's economy.



To cover the increased cost of compliance with SB 1383, a 19.89% rate increase is needed, effective January 1, 2024.

Under SB 1383, businesses are required to separate organics, including all food scraps, uncoated foodsoiled paper and yard trimmings for composting. All businesses must have compliance audits to verify they are recycling, participating in their organics program and educating their employees. Food Recovery

To reduce food waste and help feed people in need, SB 1383 requires that by 2025 California will recover 20% of edible food that would otherwise be sent to landfills. For more information go to RepublicServices.com/ClaytonCA.
