# Martinez Citywide Cleanup For the week of June 9–13, 2025



The 2025 Martinez Citywide Cleanup is scheduled for the week of June 9<sup>th</sup>–13<sup>th</sup>. During this year's cleanup, Republic Services will pick up your extra landfill waste and green waste (i.e. branches, prunings, leaves, etc.) on the same day as your regular garbage services.

Senate Bill 1383 sets statewide methane emissions reduction targets in an effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Keeping green waste out of the landfills reduces methane gas. Therefore, no green waste will be taken that is in a landfill waste cleanup pile. Please put clean green waste in cardboard boxes, BPI certified compostable bags, paper bags, or rigid containers 32 gallons or less (no plastic bags), separate from landfill waste. It will be picked up by a separate truck and composted. Consider donating items in good condition to a thrift store or during the "Reuse Roundup" Event later this year. For extra recycling, residents can schedule an on-call cleanup at no charge (limit four recycling/green waste cleanups per year). Call Republic Services at 925.685.4711 for more information or to schedule. To ensure a smooth cleanup, please comply with the following guidelines:

#### **Guidelines for Landfill Waste Cleanups:**

- Place items at the curb by 5:30 a.m. on the day of your pickup, preferably the night before your clean up day.
- All items must be stacked in one place.
- Bag or tie items with rope, cord, or string strong enough to keep bundles intact or place in containers, including metal and plastic trash cans. All containers will be taken away unless indicated otherwise with a note on the container.
- Place cleanup items in a single pile at a distance of five feet or more from your garbage container.
   No loose piles.

#### **Guidelines for Green Waste Cleanups:**

- Place items at the curb by 5:30 a.m. on the day of your pickup, preferably the night before your clean up day.
- Cut and tie branches, prunings, or wood so bundles are four feet or less in length and less than 24 inches in diameter. Tree stumps cannot be collected.
- Keep your green waste separate from your landfill waste cleanup.
- Place prunings, branches, garden/lawn trimmings, cacti, brush, plants, and leaves in cardboard boxes, paper bags, BPI Certified Compostable bags, or containers 32 gallons or less. Rigid plastic or metal containers of green waste will be left after materials are emptied.
- NO PLASTIC BAGS.

### Unacceptable Materials for Landfill Waste Cleanups:

- NO GREEN WASTE.
- No one item (or bags) may weigh more than 50 lbs or be longer than four feet.
- No electronic waste.
- No hazardous wastes including paint, oil filters, motor oil, car batteries, antifreeze, solvents, pesticides, cleaners. (No rocks, dirt, concrete, tree stumps, or large tree trunks.)
- No large appliances with freon. No dryers, heaters, ovens, or appliances with mercury switches. These items are eligible for a bulky item pick up at no charge (limit two per year).
- No large car parts (tires, engines, etc.), large furniture, or mattresses.

#### **Guidelines for Household Batteries:**

- Place batteries in a clear, quart-size plastic bag (i.e., Ziploc). Single-use AA, AAA, C, D, and 9V batteries only. No rechargeables.
- Place bagged batteries next to your recycling cart.
