



## Household Hazardous Waste

**It is illegal to throw hazardous waste in ANY of your carts.**

Take paint, pesticides, solvents, personal care products, and other household chemicals FREE OF CHARGE to Mt. View Sanitary District's Household Hazardous Waste Facility, 4797 Imhoff Place, Martinez. For more information, call 800.646.1431 or visit [mvsd.org/hhwf](http://mvsd.org/hhwf). It is illegal to put sharps (syringes, needles) in garbage or recycling.

Sharps must be in a medical sharps container and disposed of through a mail-back program or at an office drop-off site. Mt. View Sanitary District is a safe disposal location for medical sharps. The white drop-off bin is outside the administration building and available during business hours. ## Options for TVs/Monitors/Electronics

E-waste includes tvs, computer monitors, keyboards, computers, ink and toner cartridges, fax machines, cell phones, DVD players, VCR's, radios, and other electronics. ## Holidays Observed

**Only Christmas Day and New Year's Day affect service.** If the holiday falls on a weekday, all collection on and after the holiday will be pushed one day later that week.

## Senior Citizen Discount

A senior discount is available to Mt. View Sanitary District residents who are the sole user (except for legal dependents) of the utilities and are 62 years of age or older. Proof of age is required. The discount does not apply to residents with a 96-gallon garbage container. There are 4 convenient ways to pay your bill:

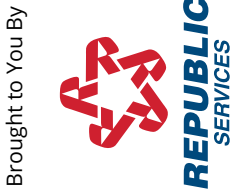

## Cart Setout Instructions

Place carts out at the curb by 6 a.m., at least 4 feet away from other carts and objects. Cart lids should be completely closed.

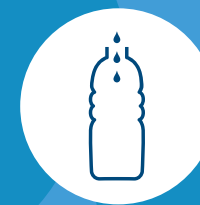


Loose (no bags), or in paper or BPI Certified Compostable bags only only.

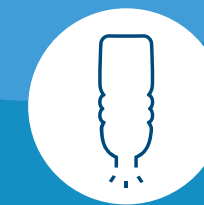
## Empty, Clean & Dry Recycling



**Empty.** Remove any remaining food or liquid.



**Clean.** Wipe or lightly rinse the item.



**Dry.** Shake out excess moisture or air dry.

## Senate Bill 1383

Composting organics is now the law!

SB 1383 is a statewide effort to reduce emissions of short-lived pollutants by reducing organics waste disposal to 75% by 2025. One of the provisions of the law requires auditing of residential garbage, recycle and organics carts. So it's important for the proper sorting of material into each cart.

## Garbage Cleanups

Residents may schedule two (2) FREE on-call cleanups per year. Cleanups can be used to discard up to two (2) cubic yards (approx. 14 32-gallon bags) of extra trash. NO GREEN WASTE ACCEPTED in a garbage cleanup. Any green waste will be tagged and left at the curb. No item or bag over 50 lbs, or 4 ft in length. No appliances (refrigerators, air conditioners, etc.), large car parts (tires, engines, etc.), large furniture or mattresses, or hazardous or e-waste. ## On-Call Cleanups for Recycling and Green Waste

Extra recycling or green waste? Use this cleanup service! Residents have two (2) FREE on-call bagged/bundled pickups (recycle or yard waste) per year.
