

Multifamily Property Owners and Managers:

Local Reuse, Recycling and Disposal Information for your Tenants

Disposing of electronics, hazardous waste, large appliances and large furniture in or near your bins is not permitted. Property management can schedule pick-up services by calling Republic Services at (925) 685-4711. Pick-up rates vary by item.

Local recycling and disposal information for your tenants:

- **Concord Recycling Center:** Cardboard boxes, electronics, metal, car parts, and some appliances. Many items are free!
- **Contra Costa Transfer Station in Martinez:** Bulky items and furniture, mattresses, and much more. Fees apply.
- **Central Sanitary District Household Hazardous Waste Facility in Martinez:** Paint, cooking oil, fluorescent lamps, propane cylinders, car batteries and much more. Free for residents.
- Post usable household furniture and home goods for reuse on websites such as Facebook Marketplace and Nextdoor, or consider donating locally.
