

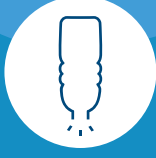
## Empty, Clean, and Dry Recycling



**Empty.** Remove any remaining food or liquid.



**Clean.** Wipe or lightly rinse the item.



**Dry.** Shake out excess moisture or air dry.

## Household Hazardous Waste

**It is illegal to throw hazardous waste in ANY of your carts.** Take paint, pesticides, solvents, personal care products, and other household chemicals FREE OF CHARGE to Central San's Household Hazardous Waste facility at 4797 Imhoff Place in Martinez. ## Garbage Cleanups

Residents may schedule two (2) FREE on call cleanups per year. Cleanups can be used to discard up to two (2) cubic yards (approx. 14 32-gallon bags) of extra trash and items that are too big for garbage carts. NO GREEN WASTE ACCEPTED. The material will be tagged and left at the curb. Call Customer Service, 925.685.4711, to schedule an on-call green waste cleanup. ## Bulky Item Pickup

Residents have two (2) large item pickups per year. Call Customer Service, 925.685.4711, to schedule a pickup. Items included are appliances (dishwasher, washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator, hot water heater, freezer, air conditioner, swamp cooler), electronics, furniture/mattresses, tires. If you need more items picked up within a year, they can be picked up for a fee.

## Going on Vacation?

**Please schedule vacation holds in advance:** Minimum 2 weeks per hold. Maximum 4 hold per year. Call Customer Service at 925.685.4711 for additional information.

## Cart Setout Instructions

Place carts out by 6:00am or the night before your collection day. Set carts next to the curb and at least 3 feet away from other carts and vehicles. Cart weight limit is 150 lbs. Cart lids should be completely closed. You may be charged for extra overflowing material.

## Senate Bill 1383: Composting organics is now the law!

SB 1383 is a statewide effort to reduce emissions of short-lived pollutants by reducing organics waste disposal to 75% by 2025. One of the provisions of the law requires auditing of residential garbage, recycle and organics carts. So it's important for the proper sorting of material into each cart.

### Residents must:

- Subscribe and participate in your curbside organics program
- Properly sort your organics into the GREEN cart
- NOT put organics in your trash cart
- NOT put organics in your on-call trash or citywide cleanup; use your on-call organics cleanups

## On-Call Cleanups for Recycling and Green Waste

Extra recycling or green waste? Use this cleanup service! Residents have three (3) FREE on call recycling/green waste cleanups per year. Green waste must be in paper or compostable bags (NO plastic bags). You can also include household batteries and/or compact fluorescent lightbulbs (CFLs) in your recycle cleanup. Recyclables should be loose (*no bags*). A second recycle cart is available at no charge. Call Customer Service to request one.

Organics should be loose (*no bags*) or in compostable or paper bags only. No plastic bags. A second green cart is available for no charge. Call Customer Service to request one.



## Food Scrap Recycling

How do you get your food scraps to your green cart? It's easy. Use a food waste pail. To keep it clean, you can line it with newspaper, a paper bag, or a BPI-Certified Compostable bag (the only type of Compostable plastic we can accept).

If you don't have a pail, contact Customer Service, 925.685.4711, and request one. The pail is FREE!



**Important:** Compostable plastics such as cold cups and utensils **do not break down** completely in our compost process. These should go in your **garbage cart**.
