Pleasant Hill Citywide Cleanup

For the week of June 16-20, 2025



Republic Services will pick up your extra trash and green waste on the same day as your regular garbage services during the week of June 16-20. SB 1383, sets statewide methane emissions reduction targets in an effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Keeping green waste out of the landfills reduces methane gas. Therefore, no green waste will be taken that is in a trash cleanup pile. Please put clean green waste in cardboard boxes, BPI certified compostable bags, or paper bags (no plastic bags) and separate it from the trash cleanup. It will be picked up by a separate truck and composted. Consider donating items in good condition to a thrift store. For extra recycling, residents can schedule an on-call cleanup (up to three free recycling/green waste cleanups per year). Call Republic Services at 925.685.4711 for more information or to schedule.

Unacceptable Materials for Trash Cleanups:

- NO GREEN WASTE IN THE TRASH CLEANUP.
- No one item (or bags or bundles) may weigh more than 50 lbs or be longer than 4'.
- · No electronic waste.
- No hazardous wastes including paint, oil filters, motor oil, car batteries, antifreeze, solvents, pesticides, cleaners. (No rocks, dirt, concrete, tree stumps or large tree trunks.)
- No large appliances. No dryers, refrigerators, heaters, ovens, or appliances with mercury switches. These items are eligible for a bulky item pick up at no charge (limit 2 per year).
- No large car parts (tires, engines, etc.), large furniture, or mattresses.

Guidelines for Green Waste Cleanups:

- Cut and tie branches, prunings or wood so bundles are 4' or less in length and less than 24" in diameter.
 Tree stumps and dirt cannot be collected.
- Keep green waste separate from your trash cleanup.
- Place prunings, branches, garden/lawn trimmings, brush, plants, and leaves in cardboard boxes, paper bags, or BPI Certified Compostable bags.
- NO PLASTIC BAGS.

Clean-ups that do not meet guidelines will NOT be picked up, and Republic will leave a Non-Collection Tag.



Guidelines for Trash Cleanups:

- Place items at the curb by 5:30 am, preferably the night before your clean up day.
- Bag or tie items with rope, cord or string strong enough to keep bundles intact.
- Place cleanup items in a single pile at a distance of 5' or more from your garbage container. No loose piles.

Guidelines for Batteries, Cell Phones:

- Place batteries in a clear, quart-size plastic bag (i.e., Ziploc). Single-use AA, AAA, C, D and 9V batteries only. No rechargeables.
- Place cell phones and chargers in a plastic bag, i.e., Ziploc. Broken phones OK.
- Place bagged batteries and cell phones next to your recycling cart.
- Please, no other e-waste will be collected.
