## **Hazardous Waste Facility**



Many products found in your home are potentially hazardous substances. They can poison, corrode, explode, or ignite when handled improperly. These substances are considered household hazardous waste that can threaten human and environmental health.

City of Fairfield, Suisun City and Unincorporated Solano County residents had a FREE Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection program. The HHW collection facility is open the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday each month from January to October and 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in November and December. The facility is open from 9 am – 12 pm.

Drop Off is by appointment only and proof of residency is required. For information and registration assistance, call HHW hotline at 707-437-8971.

At your appointment day and time, please visit our facility located at 2901 Industrial Ct. Fairfield, CA and follow the orange and black signs to the HHW unloading area. Once there, you will wait while we unload your vehicle for you.

## Restrictions

No single container larger than five (5) gallons will be accepted. The maximum allowable quantity is 15 gallons or 125 pounds per trip.

Examples of Materials accepted:

Product Type	Example
Paint	Oil and latex paint, stains, varnishes, solvents, thinners, adhesives.
Automotive Items	Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, batteries
Household cleaners and sprays	Oven cleaners, drain cleaners, bleach, waxes, polishes.
Garden Items	Pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, ant trap poison
Other chemicals	Pool chemicals, photographic chemicals, flammable liquids, aerosol cans, roofing tar, roofing products
Needles	Needles must be placed in a clear rigid enclosed container with the lid taped closed to prevent spilling.
Batteries	AA, AAA, C and D cells and button Batteries. Please place tape at the e
