Allied Waste of Ponce, Inc. was established in 1987 to expand our scope of services to municipalities and operation of landfills on the island. In 1994 once again expanded to include the operation of the first transfer station established in Puerto Rico currently in addition of Cataño. At present it provides waste collection services of 2 municipalities as well as commercial and 8,000 clients in all Puerto Rico in addition of collection of non-hazardous solid waste recycling to 28,000 residences and more than 350 business clients.

Allied Waste of Puerto Rico, Inc. has over 180 trucks for the waste collection and 262 employees. We operate municipal landfills of Salinas and Ponce and we have facilities in the municipalities of Carolina, Cataño, Arecibo and Ponce. We are the supplier of Puerto Rico's largest non-hazardous solid waste collection services, which gives us flexibility, knowledge and professionalism that address the needs of our customers.

Allied Waste is currently servicing commingle single stream commercial recycling in the metro and north areas of the island. We continue our service area expansion to procure the required island wide coverage to satisfy our customer's needs. We also provide industrial recycling with particular focus on OCC, fiber and plastics.
