Missed Collection?

Please call **209.274.2237** within 24 hours to report that your recycling, trash or yard waste cart has not been serviced. If your waste was missed because of poor weather or road conditions, double your normal waste will be collected the following week at no additional charge.

Extra Material

If you are expecting more recycling or trash than usual, please call 24 hours prior to your regular collection day to arrange for a pickup of extra waste. **If the lid on your cart does not close, you may be subject to extra charges.**

Please call to schedule for collection of extras and for additional information. If your recycling or yard waste exceeds your cart, larger or additional carts are available for a small fee.

Recycling: 32-gallon cart for no charge. 64-gallon and 96-gallon recycling carts are available for a small monthly rent in available areas.

Payment Options

Customers have four convenient ways to pay their waste bills:

- › Set up a secure account at **RepublicServices.com** to make online payments
- › By mail, using the envelope provided with your bill
- › Call **209.274.2237** to make a card payment by phone. We accept American Express, Visa, MasterCard or Discover. We do not accept checks over the phone; or
- › In person at our business office, located at 6500 Buena Vista Road, Lone CA.

There is a \$25 fee for all returned checks.

If your carts are pulled for nonpayment, there is a cart return fee if and when you wish to resume service.

Service During Holidays

There is **NO** collection on Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Collection will occur the following day for the remainder of the holiday week.

Waste will be collected on all other holidays.

Holiday Tree-Cycling

Christmas trees can be recycled free of charge at either the Buena Vista or Pine Grove Transfer Stations during regular business hours or at Amador County Airport (12380 Airport Road, Jackson) from 12/26 - 1/30. **Flocked trees will not be accepted.**

Going on Vacation?

Please schedule vacation holds in advance. **Minimum 2 weeks per hold.** We will pick up your carts if your hold is 4 weeks or longer. They will be re-delivered upon your return. Rental charges may apply if your carts are not removed during an extended vacation.

Handicap Service

At no additional cost, customers demonstrating a qualifying handicap supported by a physician's letter describing their inability to place the cart at the curb are permitted to have carts serviced at their residence.

Qualifying handicap service recipients must also provide evidence that no other occupant of the residential premises is physically able to place carts curbside for collection.

Cart Placement

- › Please place carts out for service by 6 a.m.
- › Place carts at least 3 ft. away from each other and 5 ft. away from any other object at the curb
- › Place carts with the front of the cart facing the street or alley
- › Please avoid placing carts under overhangs and wires
- › Remove carts from the street or alley as soon as possible after collection

Old/Expired Medication

Motor Oil and Oil Filters

Motor oil can be poured into a special receptacle located at both the Buena Vista and Pine Grove Transfer Stations. Oil filters can be placed in the gray box next to the oil receptacle for draining.

Motor oil and oil filters can be taken to either transfer station daily.

Cooking Oil

Pour cooking oil into a clear plastic container, like a plastic milk jug. Secure the lid with tape. Recycle cooking oil on designated household hazardous waste collection days. Never pour cooking oil down your household drain.

Acceptable Household Items

- ✓ Gasoline
- ✓ Household cleaners
- ✓ Non-empty aerosol cans
- ✓ Hydraulic fluids
- ✓ Automotive batteries
- ✓ Pesticides and insecticides
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Home-use sharps (injection needles)
- ✓ Paints and thinner
- ✓ Mercury products (thermostats and switches)

Waste is limited to 15 gallons or 125 pounds per trip.

May be taken to Meeks Lumber, Pine Grove Hardware, Pioneer Hardware or Buena Vista Landfill

- › Fluorescent tubes and bulbs
- › Household batteries

- ✗ Explosives
- ✗ Ammunition
- ✗ Narcotics

What to Put in Your Recycling, Trash & Yard Waste Carts

Recycling

Empty, clean and dry. Place items loose in your recycling cart, not in bags. ✗ **No plastic bags or wrap; no food; no liquid.**



Plastic

Empty plastic jugs and tubs



Metal

Aluminum



Glass

Bottles and jars



Paper & Cardboard

Please flatten all cardboard

Yard Waste (not included in Unincorporated Amador County Zones)

Yard and Plant Trimmings: Grass clippings, leaves, small branches and plant trimmings



✗ **No metal, glass, plastic or paper.**

Collection Guidelines

- › Place your trash cart and blue recycling cart curbside by 6 a.m. on your collection day. Blue recycling carts are for specified areas only.
- › Place your trash cart and green yard waste cart curbside by 6 a.m. on your collection day. Yard waste collection is available within the city limits of Amador City, Lone, Jackson and Sutter Creek.
- › HHW collection days: 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. at Buena Vista Transfer Station.
