Household Hazardous Waste

It is ILLEGAL to throw hazardous waste in your carts and dumpsters: Take paint, pesticides, fluorescent bulbs, motor oil & oil filters, batteries, solvents, personal care products, pharmaceuticals, e-waste, and other household chemicals FREE OF CHARGE to Delta Diablo, 2500 Pittsburg-Antioch Hwy, in Antioch.

You can dispose of sharps which include syringes, needles and lancets used in the medical care of people and animals in your home. Call (925) 756-1990 to request a free BD™ Home Sharps Container by mail. The container holds 70-100 insulin syringes or 300 pen needles. When your container is full, simply bring it to Delta Diablo and pick up another free container.

Senate Bill 1383: Composting is the law!

SB 1383 is a statewide effort to reduce emissions of shortlived climate pollutants by reducing organics waste disposal in landfills at least 75% by 2025. One of the provisions of the law requires auditing of residential garbage, recycling, and organics carts, so it's important to properly sort your materials into each cart. Help your community increase diversion from landfills, lower your carbon footprint, and avoid potential fines by separating your recycling and organics into the correct carts.

Residents must:

- Subscribe and participate in your curbside organics program
- Properly sort your organics into the **GREEN** cart
- · NOT put organics in your trash/landfill cart
- NOT put organics in your on-call trash/landfill or citywide cleanup; use your on-call organics cleanups

Food Scrap Recycling

How do you get your food scraps to your green cart? It's easy. Use a food waste pail. To keep it clean, you can line it with newspaper, a paper bag, or a BPI-Certified Compostable bag (the only type of Compostable plastic we can accept).



If you don't have a pail, contact Customer Service and request one (925) 685-4711. The pail is FREE!



Important: Compostable plastics such as cold cups and utensils do not break down completely in our compost process. These should go in your garbage cart.

Empty, Clean, and Dry Recycling

Clean. Lightly rinse or wipe the item.

Dry. Shake out excess moisture or air dry.





Household batteries

CFL's

Recyclables should be loose (no bags) or placed in a clear bag only.



Collection is biweekly. Weekly collection will begin July 1, 2024. Organics should be loose (no bags) or in compostable or paper bags only. No plastic bags. O No compostable plastic.

Garbage Cleanups

Residents may schedule two (2) FREE on call cleanups per year. Cleanups can be used to discard up to two (2) cubic yards (approx. 14 32-gallon bags) of extra trash. NO GREEN WASTE ACCEPTED. Organic material will be tagged and left at the curb.

Call Customer Service, (925) 685-4711, to schedule an oncall green waste cleanup. For details and cleanup instructions go to RepublicServices.com/AntiochCA.

Bulky Item Pickup

Residents have two (2) FREE large item pickups per year. Call Customer Service, (925) 685-4711, to schedule a pickup. Items included are appliances (dishwasher, washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator, hot water heater, freezer, air conditioner, swamp cooler), furniture/mattresses, tires. If you need more items picked up within a year, they can be picked up for a fee.

Options for TVs, Monitors, Electronics

- Keyboards, mice, speakers and other computer peripherals can be placed in brown recycling cart.
- TVs, computer monitors and other electronics can be picked up as a bulky item at the curb.

To schedule a pickup call, Customer Service, (925) 685-4711. You can also take e-waste to Delta HHW Collection Facility, free of charge, Call (925) 756-1990 for hours and information, or visit ddsd.org.

Oil Filters, Motor Oil, Batteries, and **Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFL's)**

- Pour motor oil into a clear plastic container (i.e. milk jug). Tape lid to close it securely and place beside recycling cart. Max 3 gal of oil per pickup
- Place filters in sealable plastic bag, (i.e. Ziploc, seal) beside recycling cart
- Place CFL's in plastic bag. No broken bulbs or a fee will be charged for handling the brokern CFL's. (Broken CFL's
- are hazardous; see Delta HHW Collection Facility information.)
- · Place batteries in clear, quart size plastic bag, i.e. Ziploc. Single-use AA, AAA, C, D and 9V batteries only. No rechargeables. Visit www.call2recycle.org for rechargeables.
- Place bagged batteries and CFL's NEXT TO recycling cart (NOT IN cart).

On-Call Recycling/Green Waste Cleanups

Extra recycling or green waste? Use this cleanup service! Residents have three (3) FREE on call recycling/green waste cleanups per year. You can also include household batteries and/or compact fluorescent lightbulbs (CFLs) in your recycle cleanup. Please see above section on Batteries and CFL's for set out instructions. Cart Setout Instructions

Place carts out by 6:00am or the night before your collection day. Set carts next to the curb and away from vehicles. Cart lids should be completely closed.
