Household Hazardous Waste

It is ILLEGAL to throw hazardous waste in your carts and dumpsters: Take paint, pesticides, fluorescent bulbs, motor oil & oil filters, batteries, solvents, personal care products, pharmaceuticals, e-waste, and other household chemicals FREE OF CHARGE to Delta Diablo, 2500 Pittsburg-Antioch Hwy, in Antioch.

You can dispose of sharps which include syringes, needles and lancets used in the medical care of people and animals in your home. Call 925.756.1990 to request a free BD™ Home Sharps Container by mail. The container holds 70-100 insulin syringes or 300 pen needles. When your container is full, simply bring it to Delta Diablo and pick up another free container.

No Bags Please!

Recycling and organics should be placed loose (unbagged) in their respective carts. If you need to use bags for your food scraps, only paper or BPI-certified compostable bags are allowed in the green cart. Republic Services can provide one cart exchange at no charge per year per account to help you keep your carts clean. Call Customer Service to schedule.

Senate Bill 1383: Composting is the law!

SB 1383 is a statewide effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants by reducing organics waste disposal in landfills at least 75% by 2025. One of the provisions of the law requires auditing of residential garbage, recycling, and organics carts, so it's important to properly sort your materials into each cart. Help your community increase diversion from landfills, lower your carbon footprint, and avoid potential fines by separating your recycling and organics into the correct carts.

Residents must:

- Subscribe and participate in your curbside organics program
- Properly sort your organics into the GREEN cart
- NOT put organics in your trash/landfill cart
- NOT put organics in your on-call trash/landfill or citywide cleanup; use your on-call organics cleanups

Food Scrap Recycling

How do you get your food scraps to your green cart? It's easy. Use a food waste pail. To keep it clean, you can line it with newspaper, a paper bag, or a BPI-Certified Compostable bag (the only type of Compostable plastic we can accept).

If you don't have a pail, contact Customer Service and request one 925.685.4711. The pail is FREE!



Important: Compostable plastics such as cold cups and utensils do not break down completely in our compost process. These should go in your garbage cart.

Cart Setout Instructions

Place carts out by 6:00am or the night before your collection day. Set carts next to the curb and at least 3 feet away from other carts and vehicles. Cart weight limit is 150 lbs. Cart lids should be completely closed. You may be charged for extra overflowing material.

Garbage Cleanups

Residents may schedule two (2) FREE on-call cleanups per year. Cleanups can be used to discard up to two (2) cubic yards (approx. 14 x 32-gallon bags) of extra trash. NO GREEN WASTE ACCEPTED. Organic material will be tagged and left at the curb.

Bulky Item Pickup

Residents have two (2) FREE large item pickups per year (must be scheduled in advance). Call Customer Service 925.685.4711.

Items included:

Appliances (dishwasher, washer, dryer, refrigerator, stove, hot water heater, freezer, air conditioner, swamp cooler etc.), furniture/mattresses, tires, and e-waste. If you need more items picked up within a year, they can be picked up for a fee.

Options for Electronics:

TVs, computer monitors and other electronics can be picked up as a bulky item at the curb. You can also take e-waste to Delta HHW Collection Facility, free of charge. Call 925.756.1990 for hours and information, or visit **DeltaDiablo.org**.

Oil Filters, Motor Oil, Batteries, and **Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFL's)**

- Pour motor oil into a clear plastic container (i.e. milk jug). Tape lid to close it securely and place beside recycling cart. Max 3 gallons of oil per pickup.
- Place filters in sealable plastic bag, (i.e. Ziploc, seal) next to recycling cart
- Place CFL's in sealable plastic bag, (i.e. Ziploc, seal) next to recycling cart. No broken bulbs, or a fee will be charged for handling the brokern CFL's. (Broken CFL's are hazardous; see Delta HHW Collection Facility information.)
- Place batteries in clear, quart-sized plastic bag, (i.e. Ziploc, seal) next to recycling cart. Single-use AA, AAA, C, D and 9V batteries only—no rechargeables. Visit www.call2recycle.org for rechargeables.
- All items listed must be placed **next to** recycling cart, in correct containers (NOT IN cart).

On-Call Recycling/Green Waste Cleanups

Extra recycling or green waste? Residents have three (3) FREE oncall recycling/green waste cleanups per year. Green waste must be in paper or compostable bags (NO plastic bags). You can also include household batteries and/or CFLs in your recycle cleanup. See above section on Batteries and CFL's for set out instructions.
