## Sustainability in Action

Are you a business owner looking to prevent pollution and conserve energy and water? Check out the Contra Costa County Green Business Program, a part of the California Green Business Network. This program helps small- and medium-sized businesses find ways to minimize their impact on the environment which can also save them money!

Businesses that participate in the program can get credit for green practices already in place and implement new actions that eliminate or reduce waste generated; find alternatives to hazardous materials; reduce energy and water consumption; and improve the quality of air, wastewater, and storm water discharges to become certified as a Green Business. Businesses, public agencies, and non-profit organizations are eligible to apply. Certified businesses get special recognition, are listed in the California Green Business directory, and enjoy the benefits of more efficient, healthy improvements that can attract new customers.

## Empty, Clean, and Dry

**BAGS: Compostable BPI (meets ASTM 6400 Standard); Paper Bags; No Bags**



Recyclables should be loose (*no bags*) or placed in a clear bag only.



Organics should be loose (*no bags*) or in compostable or paper bags only. No plastic bags.
