SB 1383 REQUIREMENTS

All customers must subscribe to all 3 collection streams. Even if you are self-hauling material, you still must have service. For more information on how the City of Antioch is implementing SB 1383, visit AntiochCA.gov/1074/SB-1383-Implementation

Multifamily Complexes

The property owner/manager must:

- Annually educate tenants and employees effectively on how to properly sort organic waste into the correct bins.
- Provide information to effectively educate new tenants within 14 days of new tenant's occupation of the premises.

Businesses

All businesses are required to participate in organics collection service through Republic Services. Any self-haul of organics must be separated out from other discards and hauled to a composting facility/program. Visit Resource.StopWaste.org for a full list of what can go in each cart.

- Businesses must sort all their organic waste into the correct containers.
- Businesses must provide clearly marked and correctly color-coded collection containers for organic waste together with trash and recycling containers in all areas where people generate waste.
- All businesses must provide effective education to employees, contractors, tenants, and customers on how to correctly sort organic waste into the correct container.

BAGS: Compostable BPI (meets ASTM 6400 Standard); Paper Bags; No Bags

- No Food
- No Paper
- No Green Waste

- No Liquids

- No Hazardous Waste



Recyclables should be loose (*no bags*).

- No Metal
- No Glass
- No Plastic
- No Hazardous Waste



Organics should be loose (*no bags*) or in compostable or paper bags only. No plastic bags.
