Free Christmas Tree Recycling

- Boy Scouts: The Boy Scouts will collect holiday trees on the weekends of Saturday–Sunday, Jan. 3–4, 2026, and Saturday Jan. 10, 2026 (Saturday only), by prearrangement ONLY. Please schedule your pick-up with their new app: Pickup.AntiochTroop153.org. Questions? Email troop153treepickup@gmail.com. Donations of \$30 for unflocked trees or \$40 for flocked trees, payable to BSA, would be appreciated.
- Drop-off Locations: Drop off unflocked trees 9 a.m.
 5 p.m. Saturday-Sunday, Jan. 4-5 and Jan 10-11,
 2026, in the designated areas at the Prewett Family Water Park parking lot and at the Antioch Marina Overflow parking lot at Second and L streets. Please remove tree stands before drop-off.
- **Green Container:** Place unflocked trees in green organics cart. Branches must be 6 inches or less in diameter and 3 feet or less in length. Cut off tree top. Remove tree stand. Lid must be closed.

How to Dispose of Flocked Trees

Flocked trees cannot be composted. The material in flocking makes a holiday tree unsuitable for composting. It must be treated as trash. They can be collected curbside for a fee of \$40 per tree. Pickups must be scheduled in advance; flocked trees may also be included in one of your free annual cleanups or free bulky item pickup. Call customer service at 925.685.4711 to schedule a pickup. If cut to fit inside with lid closed, flocked trees may be placed in trash container.





Recycling and Composting Reminders

- DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES. If you collect your recycling in bags, please empty the contents into your RECYCLE cart and place the bag in the GARBAGE cart.
- NO PLASTIC BAGS IN YOUR ORGANICS CART. Only BPI-Certified compostable bags (that meet ASTM 6400 Standard) should be placed in your green ORGANICS cart.
- · Clean paper and cardboard should be placed in your **RECYCLE cart.** Food-soiled, unlined (not shiny) paper and cardboard, such as paper towels, napkins, and pizza boxes should be placed in your green ORGANICS cart.



Keep your recycling loose—no bags!



Clean paper and cardboard go in the **RECYCLE** cart, <u>food-soiled</u> paper and cardboard go in the **ORGANICS** cart.
