Sustainable Materials Management Division want to make it easy for residents to dispose of their waste in an environmentally friendly way. This guide is intended to provide residents and property managers with important information about Carlsbad's recycling, organics, trash and other waste reduction and diversion programs available in the city.



Move-In Kit for Multifamily Tenants

Republic Services provides free Move-In Kits to multifamily residents to help with sorting of their recycling and organic waste prior to placement in the enclosure area (where your waste dumpsters are located).

Kits include:

- Recycling tote bag, to collect recyclables and transport them to your property's centralized recycling dumpster.
- "What Goes Where?" magnet, to hang on the fridge as a reminder of what goes into each cart or dumpster.
- Composting kitchen caddy, to collect food scraps at home and, and when it's full, take the material to the property's centralized green organics dumpster or cart. Republic Services provides free kitchen caddies for residents.
- Republic Services chip clip, to keep snacks fresh.

BULK ITEM COLLECTION

Carlsbad residents can enjoy free pickup of up to five bulky items, three times a year! To schedule, just call Republic Services at 760.332.6464. Please note, bulk pickups are based on the regular residential service day for your area, which may differ from your property's service day. Be sure to call at least 24 hours in advance.



Acceptable items:

- Furniture
- Appliances
- TVs/monitors
- Electronic waste
- Mattresses and box springs*

Unacceptable items:

- Hazardous waste
- Fencing
- Tires
- Construction/demolition
- Wood pallets
- Sinks and bathtubs

Electronic waste recycling

Anything with a plug is accepted.



Battery and light bulb recycling

- Household batteries. lithium-ion batteries and LED light bulbs are accepted.
- Fluorescent and broken light bulbs and tubes are not accepted.



Cooking and motor oil recycling

- Free used oil recovery kits are available in the office.*
- · Return containers.



Medical sharps recycling

- Place your sharps in a rigid container with a lid, such as a coffee grounds container or plastic milk jug.
- Return containers.



Moving, or have a large amount of cardboard?

Bring it to the Recycling Buyback Center for free recycling. Please ensure all cardboard is broken down.



California Redemption Value (CRV)

Residents can get CRV for bottles and cans, and recycle other materials.

Proof of residency is required for all programs.

Examples include: utility bill, waste services bill, driver's license, etc.

*The Republic Services offices are located in the building past the Recycling Buyback Center. The main door to the front desk is located on the left side of the building.

PAINTCARE RECYCLING IS HERE!

Visit PaintCare Recycling Now
Open Monday through Saturday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

There's a 5-gallon maximum limit per drop-off. Containers that are leaking, empty or without the original printed manufacturer's label are NOT ACCEPTED at drop-off sites.



PaintCare Products

These products have a fee when purchased and are accepted for free at drop-off sites:


- Interior and exterior architectural paints: latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based, enamel (including textured coatings)
- Deck coatings, floor paints (including elastomeric)
- Primers, sealers, under coaters
- Stains
- Shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes (single component)
- Waterproofing concrete/masonry/ wood sealers and repellents (not tar- or bitumen-based)
- Metal coatings, rust preventatives
- Field and lawn paints



Non-PaintCare Products

These products do not have a fee when purchased and are NOT ACCEPTED at drop-off sites:

- Paint thinners, mineral spirits, solvents
- Aerosol coatings
- Auto and marine paints
- Arts and crafts paints
- Caulking compounds, epoxies, glues, adhesives
- Paint additives, colorants, tints, resins
- Wood preservatives (containing pesticides)
- Roof patch and repair
- Asphalt-, tar- and bitumen-based products
- 2-component coatings
- Deck cleaners
- Traffic and road marking paints
- Industrial maintenance (IM) coatings
- Original equipment manufacturer (OEM) (shop application) paints and finishes
