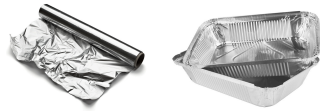

STEP 1

Provide Correct Bins



- Provide green compost, blue recycling, and black landfill bins in trash areas
- Display clear sorting signs and stickers near bins

STEP 2

Educate Your Residents



- Share this guide
- Provide residents with information upon move in
- Remind residents annually
- Keep trash areas clean and organized

STEP 3

Get Free Support



- Request free on-site consultations
- Ask for recycling program recommendations and waste reduction strategies through Republic Services
