The 2026 Martinez Citywide Cleanup is scheduled for the week of June 8–12. During this year's cleanup, Republic Services will pick up your extra landfill waste and green waste (i.e. branches, prunings, leaves, etc.) on the same day as your regular garbage services.

Senate Bill ("SB") 1383 sets statewide methane emissions reduction targets in an effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Keeping green waste out of the landfills reduces methane gas. Therefore, **no green waste will be taken that is in a landfill waste cleanup pile. Please separate from landfill waste.** It will be picked up by a separate truck and composted.

Consider donating items in good condition to a thrift store or during the "Reuse Roundup" Event in October. For extra recycling, residents can schedule an on-call cleanup at no charge (*limit four recycling/green waste cleanups per year*).

General Cleanup Reminders

- Place items at the curb by 5:30 a.m. on the day of your pickup.
- Keep landfill waste separate from green waste.
- Do not block your carts for service.
- Maximum volume for cleanups is **three** cubic yards (*roughly 18 x 32-gal trash bags*).
- No single item or bag / bundle may weigh more than 50 lbs or be longer than four feet.



Landfill Waste Guidelines

- Bag or tie items with rope, cord, or string strong enough to keep bundles intact.
- No green waste will be taken that is in a landfill waste cleanup pile (per SB 1383).

Green Waste Guidelines

- Place prunings, branches, garden/lawn trimmings, cacti, brush, plants, and leaves in paper bags, BPI Certified compostable bags, or cardboard boxes.
- Cut and tie branches, prunings, or wood so bundles are four feet or less in length and less than 24 inches in diameter.
- **No Plastic Bags.** Only paper or BPI-Certified compostable bags.

Household Battery Guidelines

- Place household batteries next to your recycling cart, sealed in a clear, quart-size plastic bag. Single-use AA, AAA, C, D, and 9V batteries only. No rechargeables.

Unacceptable Items

- No hazardous wastes including paint, oil filters, motor oil, car batteries, antifreeze, solvents, pesticides, cleaners. Drop off free of charge, to Central San's Household Hazardous Waste facility in Martinez: centralsan.org/hhw or call 800.646.1431 for info.
- No electronic waste.
- No large appliances with freon. No dryers, heaters, ovens, or appliances with mercury switches. These items are eligible for a scheduled bulky item pick up at no charge (limit two per year).
- No mattresses, large furniture, or car parts (tires, engines, etc.).
- No rocks, dirt, concrete, tree stumps, large tree trunks, or treated wood (fenceboards).
- Unacceptable items or anything over the size and weight limits will not be picked up.
