Sustainability in Action

Acceptable Items

Please consider reusing first or donating reusable items.

- Barbecues
- Branches, wood fencing and lumber (must be cut to be no larger than 4" diameter, 6' length)
- Carpeting Car seats

• Furniture

- Leaves/yard clippings (must bag)
- Mattresses
- Plastic pipes (maximum 6' length)
- Toys



- Monitors
- Televisions
- Computers
- Electronics
- Tires (limit 4)

🛿 Unacceptable Items

Please do not set out the following items.

- Automobiles or auto parts
- Boats or boat parts
- Backyard spas
- Batteries
- Bullets/shells/explosives
- Construction material, such as concrete, dirt, rocks, bricks, sheet rock or roofing material
- Large tree stumps
- Medical waste
- Propane tanks
- Steel pipes
- Hazardous waste of any kind, such as paint, cleaning products, pesticides and products labeled toxic/poison





Pile out more than 48 hours before collection -\$166.30 charge

The NCU pile may not be set at the curb prior to 48 hours before the scheduled service day. For example, if your NCU service day is Wednesday, you may set out your material anytime between 6 a.m. on Monday and 6 a.m. Wednesday. Materials set out in advance of the 48 hours may incur an Improper Large Item Collection penalty.

Cleanup guidelines

- Pile must not exceed 10 cubic yards (10' x 7' x 4').
- Lumber and plastic pipes must not exceed 6' in length.
- Loose waste must be put into boxes or bags and closed.
- On t place materials out more than 48 hours in advance of the scheduled collection day, or you may incur a \$166.30 "Improper Large Item Setout" fee.
- 8 Do not place materials next to your waste carts or parked vehicles.
- 8 Do not place materials in/near the gutter or ditches.
- On not block pedestrian or auto traffic.

When to set out your pile

Please do not set items out more than two days early. Material must be out by 6 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Use the QR code or URL on this guide to find out your scheduled NCU months. You will get a door hanger at least a week prior to notify you of your upcoming NCU collection. Note: There may be a one- or two-day collection delay due to load factors.

Pile more than 10 yards minimum \$112.91 charge

Pile size is limited to 10 cubic yards or about 10' x 7' x 4'. Residents who exceed the pile size may be subject to an excessive pile charge. The minimum charge is \$112.91 and can increase, based upon the amount of material set out.

Where to place your pile

Place items at the curb, not in the gutter. Piles need to be 5 feet away from cars, carts and other objects. Piles should not block the sidewalk and should be placed outside of drainage gutters/ditches. Place appliances, TVs, monitors and computers 1 to 2 feet from the pile.
