

#### Acceptable Items

Please consider reusing or donating reusable items first.

- Toys (batteries must be removed)
- Barbecues
- Branches and lumber (must be cut to be no larger than 4" diameter, 6' length)
- Carpeting
- Car seats
- Furniture
- Leaves/yard clippings (must bag)
- Mattresses
- Plastic pipes (maximum 6' length)
- Appliances
- Monitors
- Televisions
- Computers
- Electronics
- Tires (limit 4)

















### Unacceptable Items

Please do not set out the following items.

- Automobiles or auto parts
- Boats or boat parts
- Backyard spas
- Bullets/shells/explosives
- Construction material, such as concrete, dirt, rocks, bricks, sheet rock or roofing material
- Large tree stumps
- Medical waste
- Propane tanks
- Steel pipes
- Hazardous waste of any kind, such as paint, cleaning products, pesticides and products labeled toxic/poison

















#### Where to place your pile

Place items 1 foot away from the curb toward the street. Don't block gutter drainage. Piles need to be 5 feet away from cars, carts and other objects. Piles should not block the sidewalk and should be placed outside of drainage gutters/ditches. Place appliances, TVs, monitors and computers 1 to 2 feet from the pile.





## Residents are allowed up to three FREE bulk pickups each year.

Elk Grove residents are allowed to set out up to 5 cubic yards of recyclables, trash, green waste (including small tree stumps, not to exceed 16 inches in diameter and length) and electronic waste and up to one (1) appliance or bulk item.

Put material out no sooner than 24 hours before 6 a.m. on the scheduled day. Material must be out by 6 a.m. on the scheduled service day.
